- * CSU EO 1100 – Handout/Discussion
 - J. Parker discussed changes to the CSU GE patterns that will go into effect Fall 2018 and implications for Community Colleges.
 - The Math/Quantitative requirement includes new options (Personal Finance, Game Theory and specific Computer Science courses) and options may not require an intermediate algebra prerequisite.
 - Concerns were raised about how new options were selected.
 - The Social and Behavioral Sciences requirement was collapsed to require 3 courses from at least 2 different areas.
 - Concerns were raised about compatibility with other requirements (Major, UC, and Private Institutions).
 - J. Parker requested an extension from the Chancellor's Office but has not received a response.
 - The executive order has been challenged by the California Faculty Association and California State University – Northridge as an over-reach and having disregarded shared governance.
 - The impact on ADT degrees and Title V was discussed.
 - J. Parker suggests that discussions should continue.
 - J. Parker provided links to committee members. (* Links listed at end of minutes.)
 - J. Parker to present at Mesa Academic Senate.
 - P. Gustin thanked J. Parker for the report.
