Information

- * J. Estep welcomed new CRC Spring 2026 members L. Gonzalez faculty for Languages (Spanish) and K. Wilhite student representative. Self-introductions were done. The Spring 2026 Membership chart will be updated.
- * J. Estep and T. Teodoro reported for I. O'Connor on the following:
 - There is a proposal to adjust Title 5 to include Environmental Science under Natural Sciences for the Associate Degree Course Requirements.
 - Legislation ([AB 1552](#)) will require there be more civic emphasis/coverage in History and Government courses by 2028-29 academic year.
 - New legislation ([AB 960 Cabaldon](#)) proposes to have BACC degrees for Community Colleges that have been impacted at a CSU for more than 3 years, community colleges will be allowed to offer that Bachelor's degree.
- * CIC discussed Workplace Learning (WPL) and an Excel file will be sent to faculty to codify their Spring 2026 term their courses. Mesa's new Cinema (CINE) designator will be taken forward to CIC since CIC did not approve Mesa's request to activate the Film, Journalism, and Media Production (FJMP) designator.
- * META now has an Activation Proposal available so a Revision proposal does not have to be done for activations.
- * The Mesa Academic Senate has two resolutions (2025.12.1 & 2025.12.2) they will be reviewing in February. The CRC discussed these resolutions.
- * The Mesa Catalog Committee meets on Tues. 2/24/26 at 3 pm via Zoom.
- * Mesa's new Physical Therapist Assistant (PTA) Baccalaureate degree has been state approved! Work is being done to get the degree up and running.
- * There were no Committee Reports.
- * Ethnic Studies had no report.
- * There has been a delay to discuss Mesa's request to add Lifelong Learning to the District GE pattern.
- * There was no Cal-GETC update.
- * C. Kinney reported District has requested significant changes be made to the Liberal Arts and Sciences: Social and Behavioral Science Studies AA degree. Changes are being made.

- * J. Estep reported the new CHEM ADT template has been adjusted to 66 units so Mesa may be able to revise their CHEM ADT proposal that has been on state hold. The BIOL ADT template has been adjusted and faculty are working on updating Mesa's BIOL ADT.
- * There was no report on the STEM Calculus/AB 1705.
- * District is moving from TOP Codes to CIP Codes. Faculty were reminded that when changing to CIP Codes to be sure to review the financial effect as well as the impact on CTE programs the new CIP Code may have.
