Information/Discussion

- * The Curriculum Reporting for the Community Colleges (CRCC) Project will be presented at the November 2, 2006 CRC meeting.
- * The three handouts Instructions to Prevent Caching, Course Integrations, and CIC Action List (4/5/05-2/23/06) were distributed.
- * The CurricUNET User Group Conference agenda for Friday, October 27 at City College and registration form was distributed. Instructional Services and also E. Armstrong should be contacted if members would like to request funds for the registration fee of \$25.
- * P. Gustin advised CRC members of the current discussion at CIC for adjusting the MATH requirements for an Associate Degree with the projected implementation being done in two years. This adjustment will affect programs that are currently utilizing BUSE 101 to fulfill the MATH requirement.

- * P. Gustin reported on the challenges of updating CurricUNET for enhanced program inputting. One challenge is statements to inform students which courses are needed for the Associate Degree and/or Certificate of Achievement are not standardized. Another challenge is the listing of multiple programs under one heading. The adjustment of multiple programs under one heading into individual program proposals is currently being reviewed. Also being reviewed is the possibility of have three separate types of proposals: an Associate Degree, a Certificate of Achievement, and a Certificate of Completion.
- * P. Gustin informed CRC members of the new Six Year Review report that is now available through CurricUNET. This report lists all three college's courses and projects through the year of 2012 each course's review due date. The report is downloadable into an Excel file for sorting and reviewing individual portions of it. The Mesa's Six Year Program Review is created from data in this report.
- * J. Parker presented a handout summarizing portions of the California State University's (CSU) Lower Division Transfer Patterns (LDTP) project. J. Parker informed the committee there is a CSU statewide pattern but there are also Campus-Specific Patterns that can include additional requirements as listed on pages 5 and 6 of the handout.
- * The Tech Review report from October 12, 2006 was distributed.
- * CIC Action Summary Handout for 10/12/06 was distributed.
