Information/Discussion

- * E. Armstrong reported Mesa's walked-in ANTH 205 new course was approved and was also placed on the GE transfer list. All of Mesa's requests on the GE transfer list were approved. When this list becomes available from District it will be distributed to CRC members.
- * CIC's integration listings shows Mesa has over 100 courses left to integrate. E. Armstrong informed the committee these courses could affect Mesa's accreditation. Mesa will continue to have curriculum coordinator, E. Castaneda, during the spring semester and with assistance from J. Parker and P. Gustin it is anticipated many of these courses will be integrated by the end of the spring semester. As of fall 2008 Mesa will be limiting the offering of non-integrated courses.
- * A CIC subcommittee continues to discuss non-compliant degrees and E. Armstrong noted there is concern throughout the state regarding this change. Mesa will be affected but does have degrees that students working toward a transfer degree could be directed towards.
- * The changing of titles for certificates of completions continues in a CIC subcommittee.
- * P. Gustin reported the implementation of the program update in CurricUNET will be done during the January break. Also the course number 265 language for special topics and experimental courses continues to be discussed.
- * J. Parker reported that Pt. Loma College is another college that will not accept online courses as transferable. She also reminded members of her email for Duane Short's Holiday Party for curriculum personnel on Dec. 13 after CIC.
- * E. Castaneda reported she is changing offices but will still be in A111 for the fall semester.

- * The Tech Review Report for November 29 was distributed. A sign-up sheet was distributed for Spring Tech Review participation.
- * The CIC Action Summary Handout for November 29 was not available for distribution.
- * E. Armstrong thanked the District Instructional Office guests and invited them to make comments if they so desired.
