- J. Estep reported on Mesa's Academic Senate's Resolution 2022.9.4 Information Technology Updates Needed for Mesa College Classrooms and Faculty Offices and Adherence to the Collective Bargaining Agreement (CBA) Requirements. This resolution would require District and the four colleges to audit classrooms and office/workspace technology to determine computers and peripheral devices that need to be updated to comply with Collective Bargaining Agreement (CBA) standards and then expedite the replacement/repair of computers and peripheral devices identified in the audit. - * J. Estep also reported on Mesa's Academic Senate's Resolution 2022.9.5 Auto Enrollment. - J. Parker invited T. Mayasa to present Mesa's Academic Senate's Application to Update the Minimum Qualifications for Ethnic Studies. T. Mayasa provided background information for the need to update the Ethnic Studies minimum qualifications and emphasized the pros and cons of making the updates statewide.
