## Information

- \* Changes/suggestions for the Academic Senate's draft constitution are still being accepted by M. Parsons. The Academic Senate executive officers are reviewing the draft constitution and are anticipating having it ready by fall. M. Parsons will continue to update the committee as to changes that pertain to the CRC committee.
- M. Parsons attended the ASCCC Plenary in San Francisco April 10-12, 2014 and reported on the following items.
  - AB1451 – Concurrent enrollment (HS & College)
  - SB1068 – ACCJC accreditation of community colleges or by another federally recognized accrediting agency
  - SB850 – Award Baccalaureate Degrees at Community Colleges (The state academic Senate has a resolution to not support this bill.)
  - AB86 – Adult Education/Basic Skills
  - Enrollment Management – State statistic data from 2006 through 2013 shows the lack of repeatability had the greatest effect on Art and Physical Education enrollments.
  - Performance-based Funding – CSU Sacramento's spring 2014 presentation given by L. Varlotta included the possibility of California switching from enrollment-based funding to performance-based funding.
- \* The Curriculum Institute will be held in San Jose July 10-15, 2014. M. Parsons, E. Norvell and D. Rogers are planning to attend. Registration, travel, hotel, and car rental should be included when requesting funds to attend.
