

The California State University General Education-Breadth (CSUGE-B) pattern is one option which allows California Community College students to fulfill the lower-division general education requirements of the California State University prior to transfer. The curriculum consists of a 39-unit pattern with six areas of concentration. \*Courses listed in multiple areas shall be certified in one area.
