

## **Course Numbering System**

The course numbering system has meaning with regard to level and transfer. See the descriptions below:

- 1-49 Basic Skills or college preparatory courses. Credit does not apply toward an associate degree and is not intended for transfer to a four-year college or university. Final determination regarding the transfer of credit rests with the receiving institution.
- 50-99 Course credit applies toward the associate degree but is not intended for transfer to a four-year college university. Final determination regarding the transfer of credit rests with the receiving institution.
- Course credit applies toward the associate degree and is intended for transfer to a four-year college or university. (Some courses may be identified as associate degree applicable only. See catalog course description.) Final determination regarding the transfer of credit rests with the receiving institution.
- 300-391 Apprenticeship and in-service courses. See Catalog course description to determine credit for Associate Degree or Transfer.
- **392-399** Special Topics courses that employ a consistent disciplinary framework as described.
- **401-499** Upper Division Courses. Students must be admitted to a SDCCD college baccalaureate degree program.
