**Presently, 83 CCCs** have courses that have been granted C-ID numbers.

**1311 (+92 from April)** courses have been granted C-ID numbers for **15 disciplines** 

**294 (140 AG)** C-ID descriptors have been approved

**59** draft descriptors are closed from vetting and FDRGs are currently being convened for consideration of vetting comments.

**18** TMCs

**347** AA-T and AS-T aligned degrees approved in the Chancellor's Office
