## <u>Update on Approved Courses</u> and TMCs

**Presently, 96 CCCs** have courses that have been granted C-ID numbers; **2198** approved courses (includes TCSU courses)

**11 CSU Campuses** have identified **996** courses as comparable to C-ID descriptors

**212** C-ID descriptors have been approved – in **30** disciplines

**24** TMCs; 2 new posted as final **Philosophy** and **Spanish**

In this case, you will not have to upload a new COR.

#### Recent research by C-ID:

- **92%** of approved CORs were approved on their initial submission for review;
- the average time for courses which are approved on first submission (when there are adequate reviewers in place) is 25 days
