The 2015-16 UC Merced articulation agreements have been published in ASSIST. Below are list of this year's changes:

New Major:

Public Heath, B.A. – The Public Health major is not available to transfer students until the 2016-17 school year. Transfer students who wish to major in Public Health should complete the Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) at their community College.

Changes to Existing Majors:

Applied Mathematical Sciences, B.S. - Added 'Computational & Data Sciences' to concentration options and removed 'Custom' option.

Chemical Sciences, B.S. – CSE 005 added as a lower division alternative to CSE 020 or MATH 015:

**MATH 015 or CSE 005 may be taken in place of CSE 020 (catalog description).

Computer Science and Engineering, B.S. – Added ME 021 as a lower division alternative to CSE 021.

English, B.A. – Removed WRI 040 and added WRI 025 to lower division course options. Requirement change from 2 English courses to 3:

"Choose three of the following courses. Two courses must be from number ENG 51 to ENG 66"

New UCM English courses offered and open for articulation requests:
