New IGETC Standards Ready for Implementation

SUBJECT: New IGETC Standards

I am writing to alert you that the new Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) Standards, which were approved at the December 2007 meeting of the Intersegmental Committee of Academic Senates, have now been approved by the University of California Office of the President (UCOP) for immediate use when certifying IGETC for UC-bound students. Please note that, until an official start date is issued by the California State University (CSU), community colleges are to use the previous IGETC Standards when certifying IGETC for CSU-bound students.

These new standard reflect extensive work by representatives of the three public segments of higher education and provide greater clarity to our colleges on IGETC certification. The IGETC Standards, which were originally released in 1991, have now been expanded into a well-organized, 31-page web-based (and searchable) manual. Trainings on the new IGETC Standards will be held at all four of the upcoming Ensuring Transfer Success (ETS) Institutes, and at the California Association of Community Colleges Registrars and Admissions Officers (CACCRAO) Conference in Lake Tahoe. In addition, presentations will be conducted at the California Intersegmental Articulation Council (CIAC) Conference in San Luis Obispo and at the Fall 2008 UC Counselor Conferences. Please encourage a member of your staff or counseling faculty to attend one of these trainings.
