It can happen in a few minutes or over years.</li> <li>The Mentor &amp; Match platform connects students with mentors on campus. We have models for this, like the Student Success Coaches, but this may open the opportunity for more cohorts of students.</li> <li>This program is facilitated through a mobile platform (iOS, Android) that features mentor cards with mentor pictures and points of interest and personal qualities that may be important for prospective mentees.</li> <li>An algorithm will help make matches. <ul> <li>Student Affairs</li> <li>Student Affairs: Next week is our big pep rally from 12-2.</li> <li>Financial Aid: There have been several challenges with financial aid. There was a big overhaul to FA. It will be positive eventually, but</li> </ul>

challenging now. The app won't be available until Dec 1. This will make the next academic year difficult. Much of this is not under our control. What we used to do in April/May was done in late July. Student notifications were delayed. FA has been working with different offices to help students. Dream Act applicants' applications have been delayed and they're just now being processed. We'll be in a better place in mid-October in terms of funds distributed. Campus of Record changes: This is handled by FA. If a student has already been awarded certain types of financial aid, they may be ineligible for some services at colleges not attached to the college of record, but it's very difficult to change this once funds have been awarded. Saul and Pilar handle this. They are not processed mid-year/post-fall.

- Outreach & Promise: We are having a <u>Cal-SOAP</u> college and career fair on Wed, Oct 23. Hosted on Mesa campus. Departments can reserve a Mesa table. If you're interested, let Jen know. Cal-SOAP College & Career Fair on Wed, October 23rd. 6pm-8pm on Mesa campus. If you would like to represent your program or office at the fair, you can do this free of charge. - Student Health Services: A recent email went out related to COVID.
   Vaccines will be available on October 9. We'll be giving out free flu shots for students. Narcan boxes have been delivered. There's one on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> floors. Narcan will not harm someone who has no narcotics in their system.
