1. Critical Thinking ILO Assessment Group 1: Graduate Survey,

Members: Ed Helscher, Tina Recalde, Claudia Estrada-Howell, and Raquel Aparicio

- Discussed limiting survey questions related to critical thinking to ten.
 - "What is critical thinking?" (Five questions)
 - For example: "Critical thinking concerns: [blank]" to see if the student understands the definition of critical thinking
 - For example: "The worst approach to gauging the reliability of news sources is to: [blank]" <u>Three</u> answer choices that are really good ways to evaluate a news source and <u>one</u> that is not so good.
 - Student capabilities of critical thinking (Five questions)
 - Use a Likert Scale that is modeled after the Global Awareness question format.

Group 2: ILO Assessment

Members: Linda Hensley, Michael McLaren, Michael Temple, Manuel Velez and Ailene Crakes

- Discussed how to best accurately gauge critical thinking as an ILO.
- Questions were raised about:
 - There are different ways critical thinking is defined across disciplines.
 - Making critical thinking a requirement as an assignment, could infringe upon academic freedom for faculty.
- A suggestion was brought up: The DOC's and Chairs could discuss what critical thinking means to their disciplines. DOC's /Chairs could create their own assessment or offer measurement tools to determine whether students are successful in critical thinking.
- Ask the DOC's/ Chairs questions:
 - How did your discipline choose to assess critical

thinking as an ILO? How did you measure success for critical thinking in your discipline? What were the results of your assessment? Share data and results. Not just instructional side but the services side. DOC summit is scheduled for March 6, 2020 10:00 a.m1:00 p.m. however, many members will not be able to make it on that day. Discussion about sending out critical thinking ILO Assessment Share-outs to Pilot DOC's to get their feedback.
