AB 928

- A single, transfer GE (General Education) pattern
 - *CSU Breadth & IGETC* → *CalGETC*

ADTs

- ADTs require a TMC Template and Narrative ICYDK
 - *Associate Degrees for Transfer require a Transfer Model Curriculum Template*
- TMC Templates and Narratives reference GE
 - Double count to ensure required units stay under 60, etc.

ADTs

- TMC Templates list courses that *must be* included in the ADT and courses that *may be* included (and the evidence we need to provide)
 - **C-ID** *California Identification Number*
 - **AAM** *Articulation Agreement by Major*
 - **BCT** *CSU Baccalaureate Course Transfer List*
 - **GECC** *CSU GE Certification List*

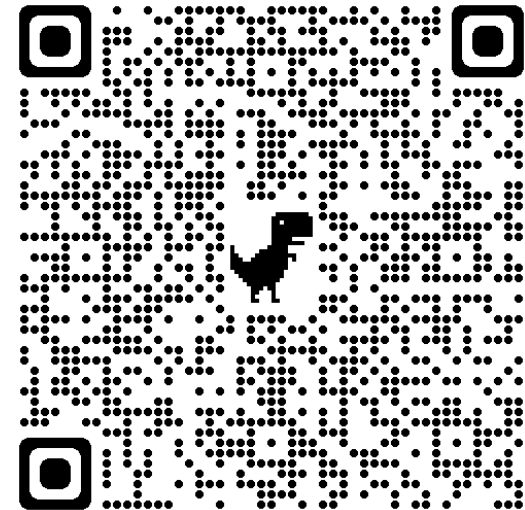

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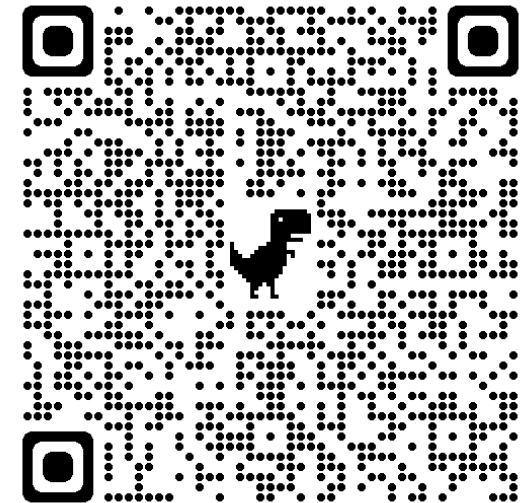
