

Associate Degrees for Transfer

- Complete by Feb 29, 2024



- 30 local AA/AS degree and certificate programs
- GE: District or Cal-GETC
- Complete by March 22, 2024



Remaining Local AA/AS Degrees + Certificates

- 35 local AA/AS degree and certificate programs
- GE: District or Cal-GETC
- Complete by April 19, 2024



Department Approval/Signoff
