
I hope you're having a fantastic week!

Please remember that each CLO for every course needs to be assessed at least once within our 4-year timeline, which will conclude on June 30, 2026. Additionally, COA wanted to share a few important updates and reminders. These changes aren't new, but they aim to streamline our outcomes assessment process and show ACCJC that we're adhering to Mesa's timeline and engaging in discussions about the data we're collecting.

1. Space in Nuventive for Closing the Loop- Outcomes Discussions:


- a. Several of you have contacted me asking for a space to document a summary of your outcomes across campus meetings, the meeting where you discuss your outcomes.
 There is now a space in Nuventive where you can add a brief summary of the conversations and next steps your department created.
- b. Navigate to "Courses>Discipline" and select "Reflections and Action Plans".




c. Click on the green "+" to create a new form:

Hi, DOCs!

I want to start off by thanking you again for your support getting the correct CLOs on Fall 2024 syllabi. I have also sent the CLOs over to our Dean of Curriculum and Instructional Services so that we can update Curriqunet Meta, or new curriculum managements system. Please don't look to meta because the CLOs are not yet aligned and accurate. Our Committee on Outcomes and Assessment (COA) is also working closely with our Curriculum Committee to improve the communication and exchange of information between Nuventive and Meta.

Regarding our 4-Year Outcomes timeline, we are now in year 3. What's happening in year 3? Hopefully by this point, you have assessed the gateway courses in your areas and discussed the data you collected with your department this semester. Student Services has also begun their assessments as well as discussions on the previous year's data.
