Whereas, the local curriculum committee has the responsibility as part of the curriculum approval process to engage the discipline faculty in a separate review of the course for the following: academic integrity and rigor, the method of meeting Carnegie units, the ability of the students to complete and for faculty to evaluate assignments, including those done outside of class, and the appropriateness of the method of delivery, to determine whether the course should be offered in a specific shortened time frame; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the San Diego Mesa College Academic Senate direct the Curriculum Committee to engage the discipline in reviewing and approving all courses for three or more units that will be offered in less than six weeks. Results
