# DISCUSSIO

- a) President- Charlie Lieu
  - 4/20/21 PCAB (Recap) Support from AFT to navigate challenging discussion on return to campus. Athletes coming back in the summer for conditioning. Isabel O'Connor, Vice President of Instruction, supports a safe return to campus but first review which courses can come back, which can wait.
  - 4/14/21 Campus Reopening Committee (Recap) Taskforce for PCAB
     event that occurred several months ago: They shared proposals and
     received approval from PCAB to support their proposal and some of the
     ideas are on hosting a series on restorative justice sessions. The whole idea
     at end of the day is to empower everyone to use our voice, how do you
     step up to protect coworker if you feel they are being treated unjustly.
     SDAIE committee will support to help implement this proposal.
- b) Vice President- Eva Parrill
  - 4/21/21 DGC (Recap) Chancellor Carol recommends 25-50% teaching on campus, plan to be back on campus fully by January 2022. They are still planning a slow reintegration from remote work to back to campus.
- c) Senate Manager Alicia Lopez

- d) Treasurer- Alan Goodman
  - 4/7/21 Budget Planning and Development Council Most of the
    information has not changed, February 21 state began deferments of
    apportionment. State set aside "a hardship exemption" 30 million dollars.
    Our district deferred and we received an apportionment. If we are
    approved for it, the district does not have to file the TRAN which is the
    borrowed money and we will save on that. We expect to get paid for
    deferrals and end deferrals until next fiscal year.
    - On our end, we've spend 60% less on utilities. We saved but have not hit our AFTs targets.
    - Year 2023-24 is when hold harmless ends and also is the funding formula doesn't change or changes. Our hiring freeze will continue because 90% of costs are personnel. We are hiring critical positions for some departments.

- Adding classified stipend as a line item, library services paid by Miramar for district, mesa pays all the Scranton's for district. CAM (campus allocation model) is being reworked.
- O BARC- got a brand new rubric for BARC request and divided up at PIE. 3 rounds of funding from government. 1st CARES next #2 HERF (we are receiving this one now) and #3 later. We are good and within budget but there are still structural issues at the district with the hiring freeze. A lot of the relief money has changed the picture of one time monies.
- Classified Stipend-April for Classified FT and May 10 for NANCE employees.
