- 3. How are New Mesa College Faculty Members assigned to committee?
- 4. Academic Senate Vice President Dina Miyoshi is putting together definitions including what is a committee verses an inquiry group verses a task force verses a work group.
- 5. Joe Safdie asked if Faculty Members' committee memberships can be included in their directory information.
- 6. We will research committee structures at other institutions including their websites.
