The group discussed possible roles and responsibilities as well as recommended compensation for the new Outcomes Coordinator and **Ed Helscher** presented a proposal to the group. Anda McComb shared a brief summary of DOCs feedback for how they see Outcomes Assessment in the future that included:

- -Collaboration
- -Add Equity and Excellence and Mesa 2030 goals in the OA process
- -Use Canvas as a platform
- -Using the same assessment tools within departments (e.g. rubrics)

The group agreed that a next step is to hire a new faculty outcomes coordinator for the campus.
