- ➤ We have changed our completion rates from 75% to 80%
- We currently are looking at ways to engage the student experience as the campus evolves with new buildings and programs.
- We will be adding to the orientation through video/photo/new translations and content.

- Focus of Assessment
  - Course Learning Outcomes: Re-evaluate the effectiveness and number of CLOs per course.
  - Specific CLOs: To this point, our focus has been on *Critical Thinking* and *Communication*.
  - Student Success and Retention: How do our CLOs relate to school-wide performance indicators? How can courses work to improve Student Success in our courses?
- Challenges To Assessment
  - Absence of Dr. César López
  - Coordination With Instructors
  - o Ensuring that Assessments provide an accurate picture
- What did we learn?
  - Current CLOs for certain classes should be condensed/reduced
  - Students tend to do well in the specific assignments that are assessed (On average 75% of our students receive passing grades in the assignments that are assessed).
- Next Steps
  - Address the disparity between outcomes assessment and Student Success and Retention Rates
  - o Begin to process to minimize CLOs for certain courses.
  - o Encourage inter-faculty dialogue and culturally relevant pedagogy.
