 - ii. STEM Center is at capacity with students. They have served more than 300 unique students.
 - iii. Leland and Parsons hosted a workshop at Convocation based on Servingness.
 - iv. Latino Heritage Month Event in the quad on Thursday September 14, 2023.
 - v. Will be presenting at President Cabinet on October 3, 2023.
- I. AANAPISI Programs (Simpliciano)
 - i. Funding timeline is from July to June while the grant timeline is from October to September and the funding wraps up year two and entering year three.
 - ii. Grant objectives are to increase enrollment, persistence, graduation, the utilization of the services, the career center, their learning community I Copla, and increasing professional development.
