	A. Statewide Call To Action, Review of Equity Plans		
COMMENTS/ DISCUSSION	 We set as part of our agenda to implement a review of our plan to answer the following: Is the Mesa Equity Plans designed for compliance or for outcomes? To ensure candid conversations about the limitations and barriers to pushing the agenda forward, accelerate the work. Pull together cross-campus teams to focus on naming barrier, identifying solutions and rallying the campus to meet needs. B. Ensuring Equity in Guided Pathways As we have cross-participants in both committees (SET & Guided Pathways), we intend to make presentations and recommendations on ideas generating from the committee to ensure equity minded approaches are being discussed and included as part of the discussion. 		

C. Overview of OPP (Crakes)
 Dean Crakes shared a presentation on the plans and purpose of a new program geared towards student athletes, OPP (Olympian Pathways Prototype). Significance of the program was discussed as a pathways model but also highlighted the strength of the program as an intentional equity approach particularly related to the proportionate number of Black and Brown students who engage in athletics compared to their general numbers. It is our intention to work closely with the program to ensure that all members are trained in equity minded approaches.
