Context

• In 2017-2018, students who reported living in the north county service area comprised the following proportions of overall FTES at each college and Continuing Education:

City College: 5% or 529 FTES
 Mesa College: 10% or 1,571 FTES
 Miramar College: 33% or 3,299 FTES
 Continuing Education: 6% or 609 FTES

- Most students who reported living in this service area live in Rancho Bernardo, Poway, and Rancho Peñasquitos.
- In general, FTES from this service area has steadily increased over the past several academic years at each college and Continuing Education.

Spring 2019

 While FTES declined at each college, Continuing Education observed an increase in Spring 2019 from the north country service area:

City College: -6 FTES or -3%
 Mesa College: -70 FTES or -10%
 Miramar College: -87 FTES or -6%

o Continuing Education: +24 FTES or +9%

• This trend at CE is consistent throughout this academic year and is likely because there are few other non-credit offerings in this part of the county.

2018-2019 Academic Year

 Despite some variation by term, FTES from students in the north county service area has declined this academic year at the credit colleges and increased at Continuing Education:

City College: -34 FTES or -7%
 Mesa College: -115 FTES or -7%
 Miramar College: -44 FTES or -1%

Continuing Education: +46 FTES or +7%

- FTES from students who live in the Rancho Bernardo and Poway area declined across
 the colleges with the exception of City College (City College: +2%, Mesa College: -12%,
 Miramar College: -6%). This may be due to the popularity of City College's cosmetology
 and building trade programs amongst students from this region according to past
 SDCCD research.
- Total FTES from students who reported living in the north county service area:

City College: 489 FTES
 Mesa College: 1,454 FTES
 Miramar College: 3,250 FTES
 Continuing Education: 666 FTES
