Percentage of Black students who received student health, mental health care services last year.

5.92%

Looking to raise the participation in mental health services by 10%

Why is this important?

Mass witnessing of Black persons being murdered on internet & TV. Transparency in videos has further revealed system of unjust violence against persons who are black.

- Current & historical events can cause the following conditions:
 - Acute stress
 - Racially based trauma
 - ► Post-traumatic stress


