





Student Email and Microsoft 365



- Student email: @student.sdccd.edu
- Cloud platform to access Microsoft applications
- 1TB storage on OneDrive
- Install Microsoft Office to your personal computers


Scenario:





- ✓ Enrolled at least with 1 class for the current term
- ✓ Does not have an S40 hold on their account
- Does not already have another student.sdccd.edu on their account

How can students get started?



- Students will receive an email notifying them to set up their student email 2 hours after enrolling into a class
- The student's full SDCCD email address will be their log in



 Their password will be the same password to their student portal -> mySDCCD




Steps to set up Student Email:





> an authentication method that requires you to provide two or more verification factors to gain access to an application




- Microsoft Authenticator (Mobile App)
- 2. Text or Phone Call
- 3. Other Authenticator App (Google Authenticate)

What are the options for students who do not have access to phone, mobile devices, etc?








- Students will submit a ticket to request a key fob
- Once a key fob is setup, student will receive a 6-digit code when logging in
- Key fob should be treated as a wallet
- Battery life 5-7 years
- Process should go live in the next 2 weeks



• **No**, if you are using a public computer or workstation








Ways to access Microsoft 365 with your SDCCD student email account:

- 1. Download to desktop
- 2. Internet Browser
- 3. Mobile App

Q1: What happens to the student email address when a student does a name change?

- Turn in a mySDCCD Help Desk ticket to request a name change (This is only for LEGAL NAME CHANGE)
 - a. Government Issued Photo ID
 - b. Name Change Supporting Document
- 2. Name change will be processed in the student portal
- 3. Once the name change is reflected in the student portal and the ticket is marked as "Done", student will receive an email notifying of the change.
 - *Processing time for a new email: 24 hours once student portal is updated

Q2: What to do if a student does not want to use their SDCCD student email?



Q3: How long will student have access to their student email and Microsoft 365 apps?

- Students will have access as long as they are enrolled in City, Mesa, Miramar, or CCE
- Will lose access after 3 semesters of not attending
- Will be assigned to same email address if returning
