## Academic and Career Pathways (ACPs):

Vice President Isabel O'Connor provided an update regarding Academic and Career Pathways (ACP) placement at PCAB on Tuesday, October 3r. Departments may now choose up to <u>three</u> ACPs for their academic programs to be placed. The update was based on careful consideration and consultation with some faculty who shared concerns.

The deadline for academic programs to make adjustments to their ACP placement was Monday, October 16<sup>th</sup>. Many thanks to the departments who submitted updates to their placement, as academic programs may now be placed in up to three Academic and Career Pathways. Mesa Pathways Leadership Team is now in the process of updating these programs listings, which will be reflected on the Academic and Career Pathways website by mid-November: https://www.sdmesa.edu/academics/v2/academic-career-pathways/index.shtml .

These ACP updates will also be submitted to the district so that these changes can be reflected in the updates to CCCApply. In future terms, incoming students will be able to select their major via ACP in CCCApply.
