

## Path to STEM Success Spring 2023 Enrollments Survey report

### Purpose & methodology:

The Path to STEM Success Spring 2023 Enrollments survey was conducted in Fall 2022 to collect student responses regarding their current and planned STEM course enrollments. The feedback survey aimed to inform the Path to STEM Success Intersession agendas. Path to STEM Success instructors were provided a web link and QR code to the feedback survey, which was distributed to their courses from November 9th, 2022, through December 13th, 2022. A total of 132 students responded to the survey.

### **Demographic data summary:**


- Most (37.9%) of respondents were biology majors. There were 27 responses (20.5%) from non-STEM majors, including kinesiology and nursing.
- Half (50.0%) of respondents were enrolled in CHEM 200 in Fall 2022.
- Most (69.1%) of respondents have a comprehensive education plan.
- Only 26 respondents (18.7%) have seen a STEM specific counselor either this semester
  or before this semester. However, 60.2% of respondents would like to meet with a STEM
  counselor.
- The top three activities that students were interested in attending are: 1) STEM transfer general information session 2) STEM counseling general information session and 3) Industry/internship opportunities panel.
- About a third (34.4%) of survey respondents were Latinx.

#### Course combination data summary:

- Students enrolled in CHEM 152 Fall 2022 → CHEM 200 Spring 2023
  - All (100%) of respondents plan to take CHEM 200 in Spring 2023. Some also intend on enrolling in CHEM 201.
- Students enrolled in CHEM 200 Fall 2022 → CHEM 201 Spring 2023
  - Most (57.5%) respondents were concurrently enrolled in BIOL 210A.
  - All (100%) respondents plan to take CHEM 201 in Spring 2023.
  - Most (52.5%) respondents plan to take BIOL 210B in Spring 2023.
- Students enrolled in CHEM 152 Fall 2022 → BIOL 210A Spring 2023
  - All (100%) respondents plan to take BIOL 210A in Spring 2023.
- Students enrolled in BIOL 210A Fall 2022 → BIOL 210B Spring 2023
  - Most (66.7%) respondents were concurrently enrolled in CHEM 200.
  - Most (66.7%) respondents plan to take CHEM 201 in Spring 2023.
  - All (100%) respondents plan to take BIOL 210B in Spring 2023.



## Q11 Do you have a comprehensive education plan?



### Q12 Have you seen a STEM specific counselor before?



## Q13 Have you seen a transfer/career center counselor before?



# Q14 Which of the following activities would you attend if offered? [Check all that apply]







### Q17 What is your sexual orientation?



## Q18 What is your age group?


