Despite all the scarcity during his childhood and the political climate on the island of Cuba, Pavel pursued his dream to become a teacher. Pavel was born and raised in Nicaro, a little beach and industrial town of Cuba. Both of his parents worked for the local nickle company under the rule of the Cuban Communist govenment. At the age of 14, he took advantage to work as a teacher's assistant for a local middle school; a profession that marked his life forever. Pavel continued his education and career goal by graduating from Pedagogical Vocational High School and attending Pedagogical University in Holguin, Cuba. After successfully obtaining a Bachelor of Education, with a minor in English Language, Pavel's passion for understanding the worlds' complexities led him to enroll in graduate school in Tijuana, Baja California, Mexico, where he earned his Master's and Doctorate in Global Development Studies.
