1) Comment:

However...in my opinion, unless there is a particular reason for such detail, the Student Learning Objectives and the Outline of Topics (6 pages?) are way too detailed. It just seems that a lot of the subtopics could be combined or eliminated--for example, do all of George Kelly's corollaries need to be listed? Also, while I realize that new or non-mainstream (if there are any) theories are slow to be developed and accepted, should there be something to allow inclusion of something new?

Could the end of the second to the last sentence of the Course Description be changed from "...applications of them." to "...applications of their theories."? Kind of awkward as it is currently written.

There are a couple of upside down question marks in the Outline of Topics--III-C-1 and III-E-7. "Pshychology" is misspelled in III-C-8.

Reading Assignment II is not clear to me--are there some extra words there?
