## Mesa ILOs (2015)

- Communication
- Critical Thinking
- Global Awareness
- Personal Awareness & Civic Responsibility
- Self-Awareness & Interpersonal Skills
- Technological Awareness

## Survey Instrument

- 6 Likert scale matrix questions (1 per ILO)
  - Ratings on a 5-point scale
  - Open-ended comment boxes for each ILO
- 6 additional open-ended items
  - Success factors, challenges, recommendations
- Students asked to rate the degree to which their experiences at Mesa improved their skills/abilities in each area

## Methodology

- Survey sent to students in April 2015
- Data collection: April-May 2015
- One invitation, two reminders
- Target population: students applying for graduation during spring semester
  - N=1,856 students
  - Survey invitation sent via email to 1,843 students


## **Survey Participants**

- 483 students responded to the survey invitation
- 428 students completed the survey
- Response rate= 23%




## Summary of Responses by ILO

**Personal Awareness Average Skill Improvement Ratings** 




