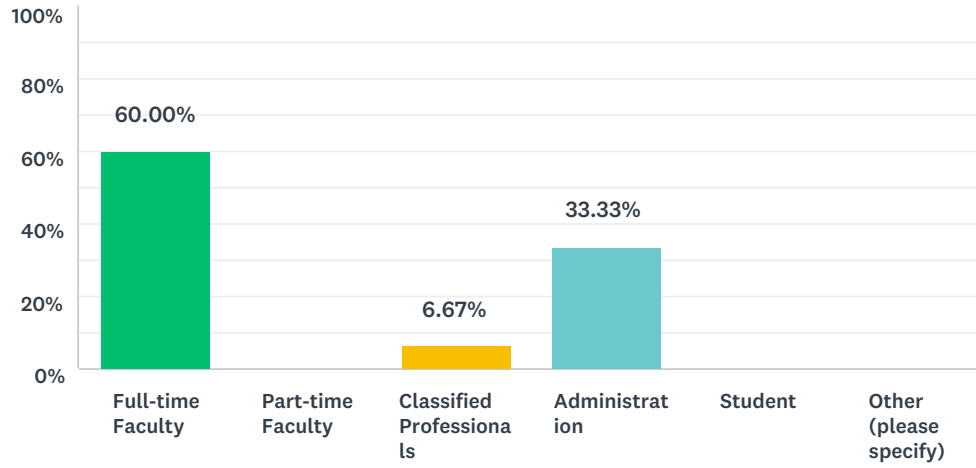

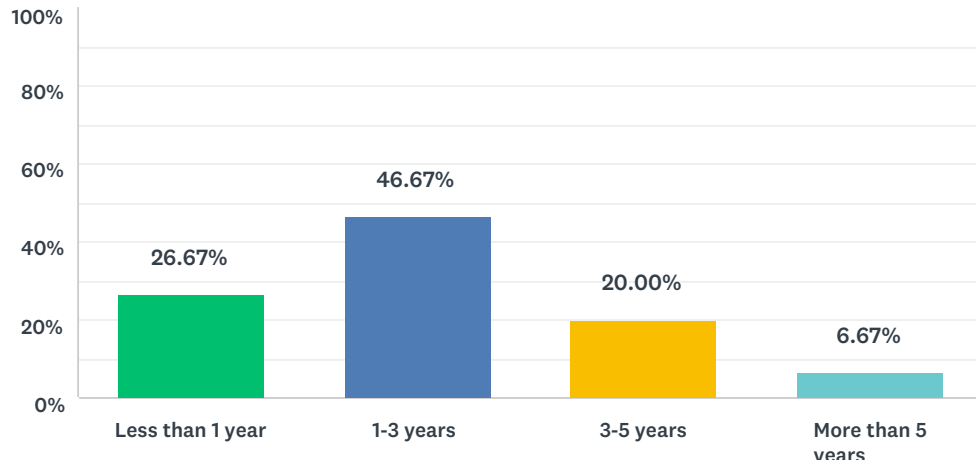

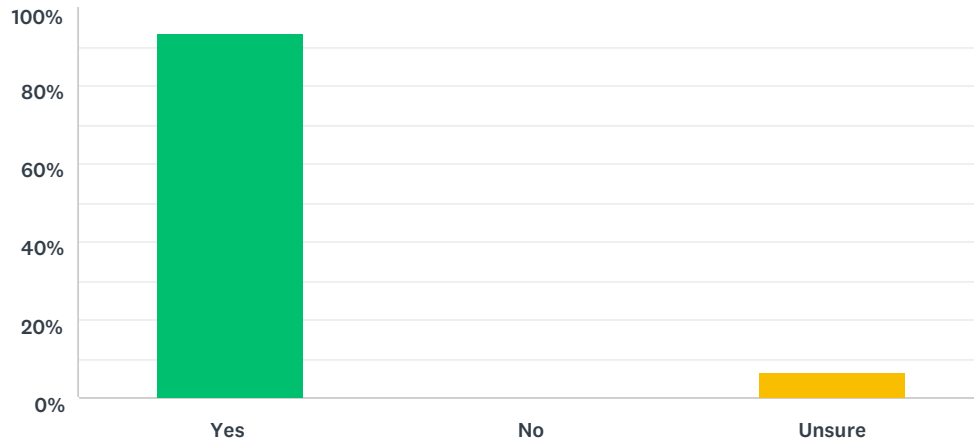
Q3 How many years have you served continuously on the committee you selected?

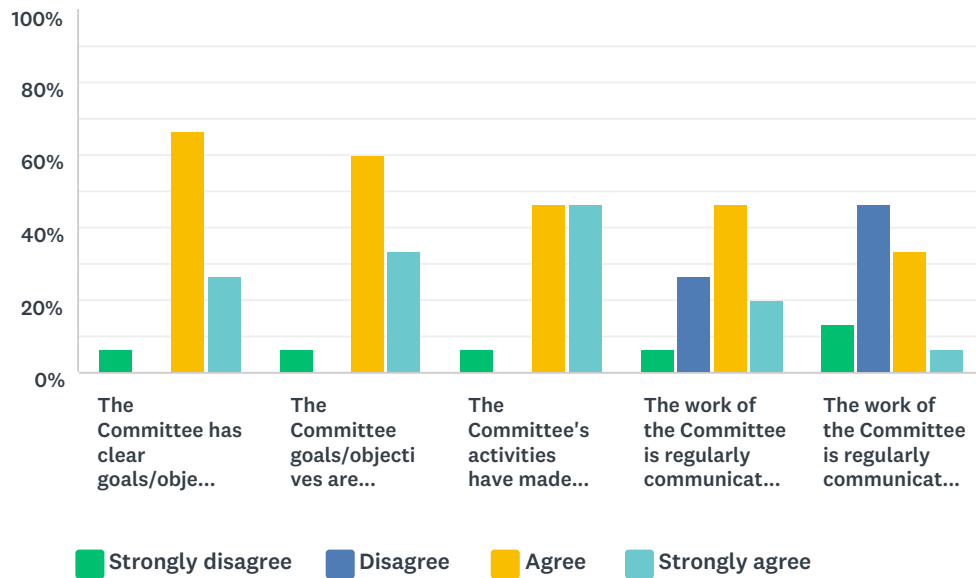

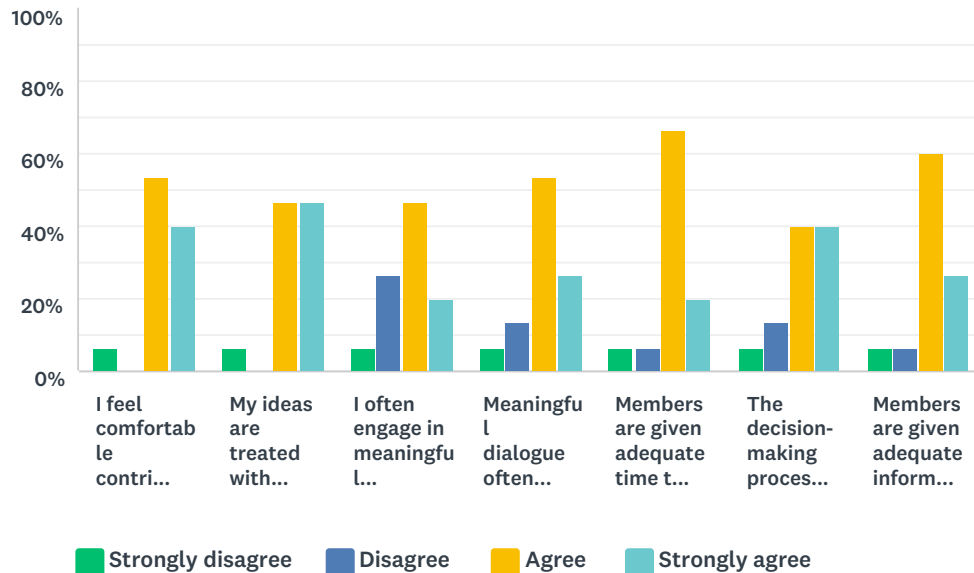

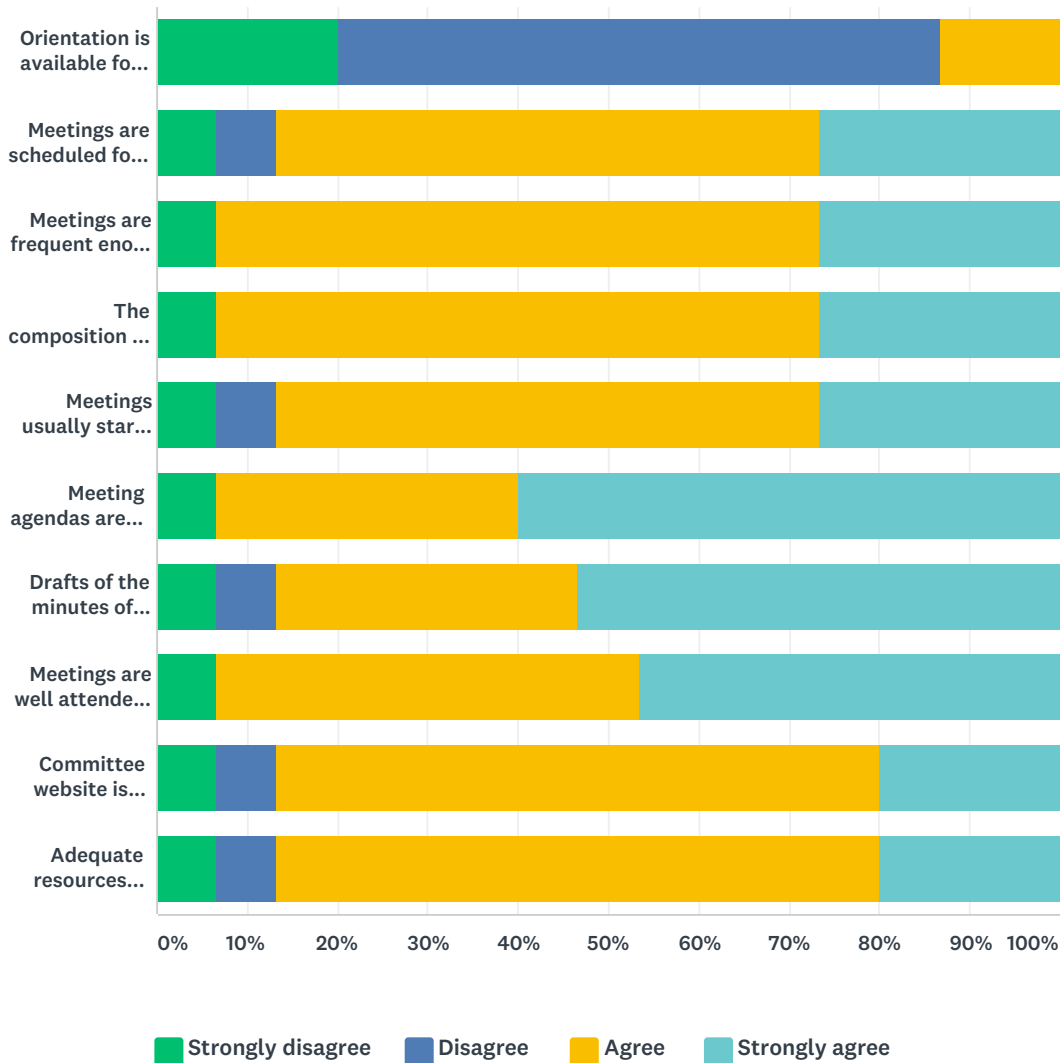
