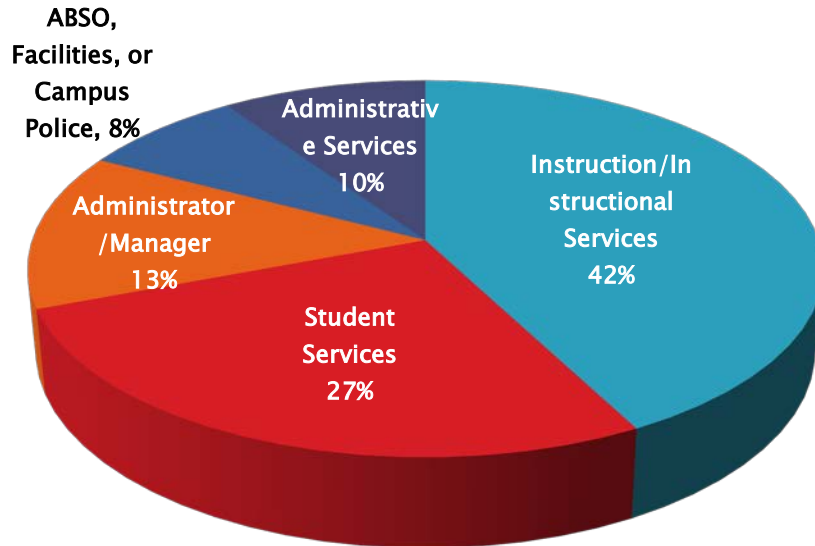

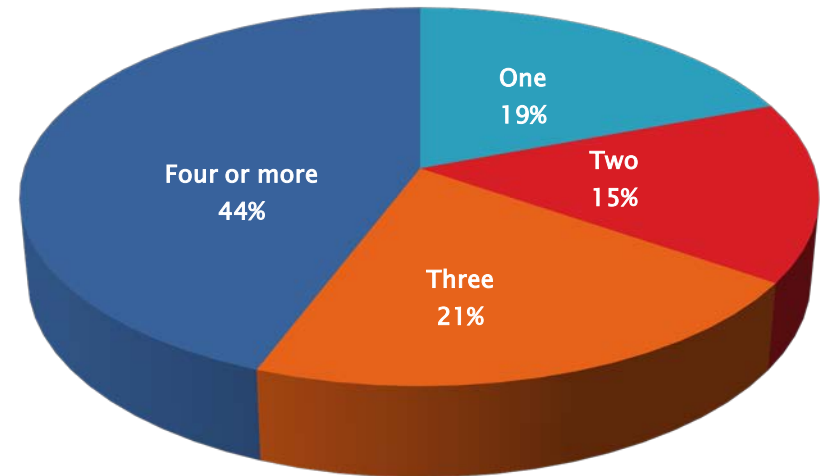

Q1. Departments

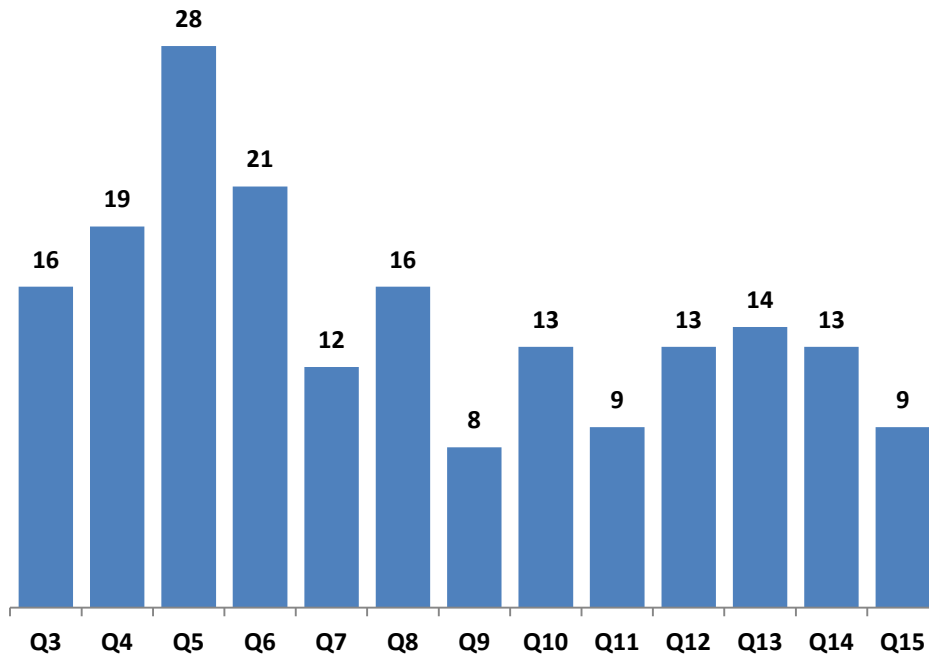


Q2. Number of Classified Conferences Attended

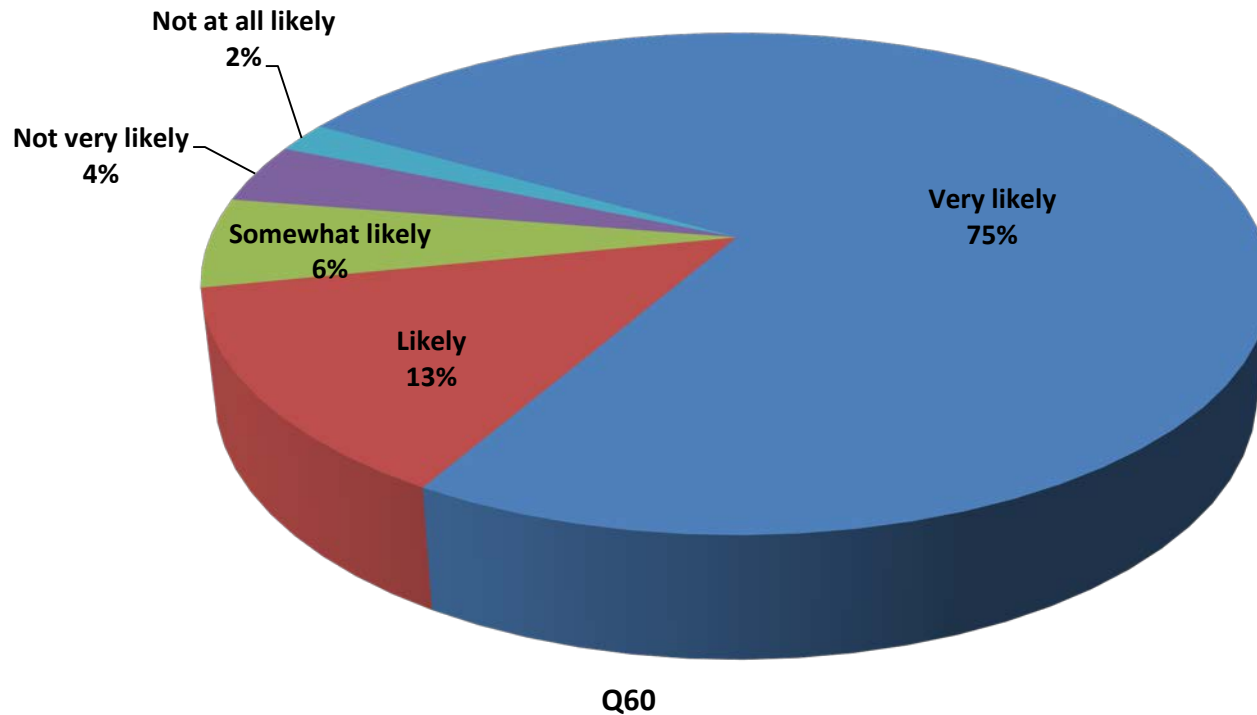
