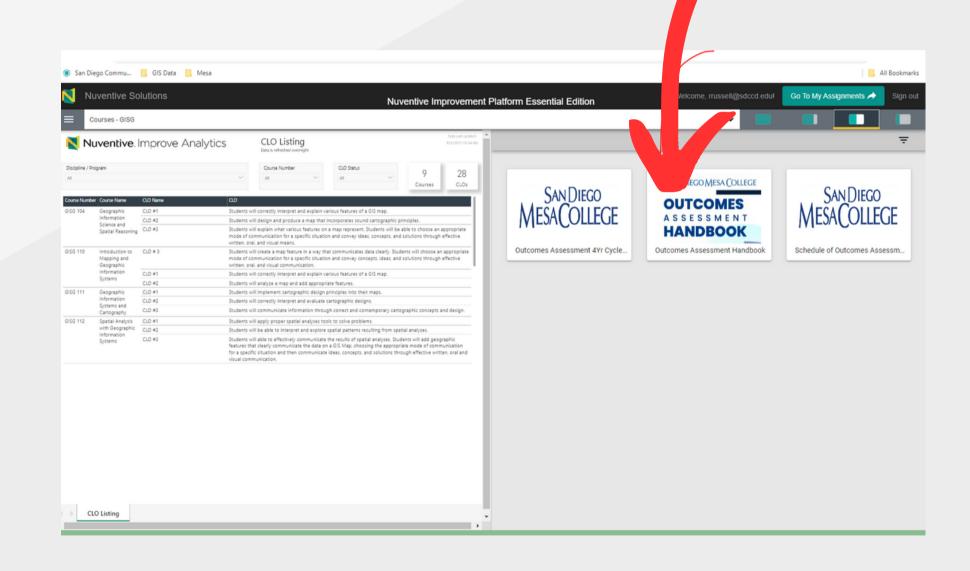

#### WHY DO WE NEED ILOS

- It is our duty to evaluate how effectively our courses, programs, and services facilitate our students' learning and development.
- Guiding principles for instruction, tied to mission and vision of our college.
- Assessment supports
  - Equitable, accessible, and meaningful learning experience for all Mesa
     Students
  - Continuous quality improvement of instruction and services
  - Curriculum development, resource needs

#### ILOS GUIDE OUTCOME ASSESSMENT

Process of collecting information that will tell us whether the programs, services, activities, and experiences we provide have the desired impact on student learning. Learning outcomes help us identify knowledge and skill sets that students learn as a result of our courses, programs, and service units. In higher education, Learning Outcomes Assessment has three stages:

- 1. Define the most important goal(s) of an academic experience and help students achieve those goals (learning outcome).
- 2. Evaluate how well students achieved the goal(s) (assessment).
- 3. Use the results to improve academic experience (closing the loop).

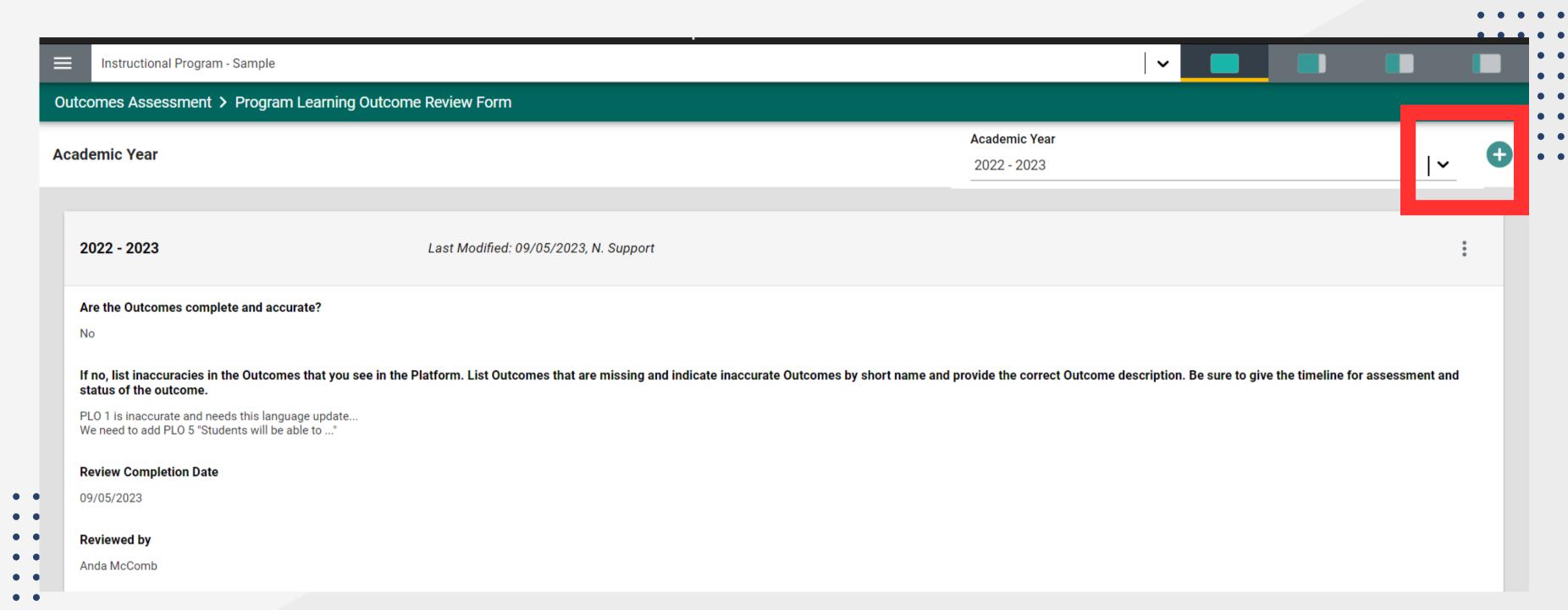

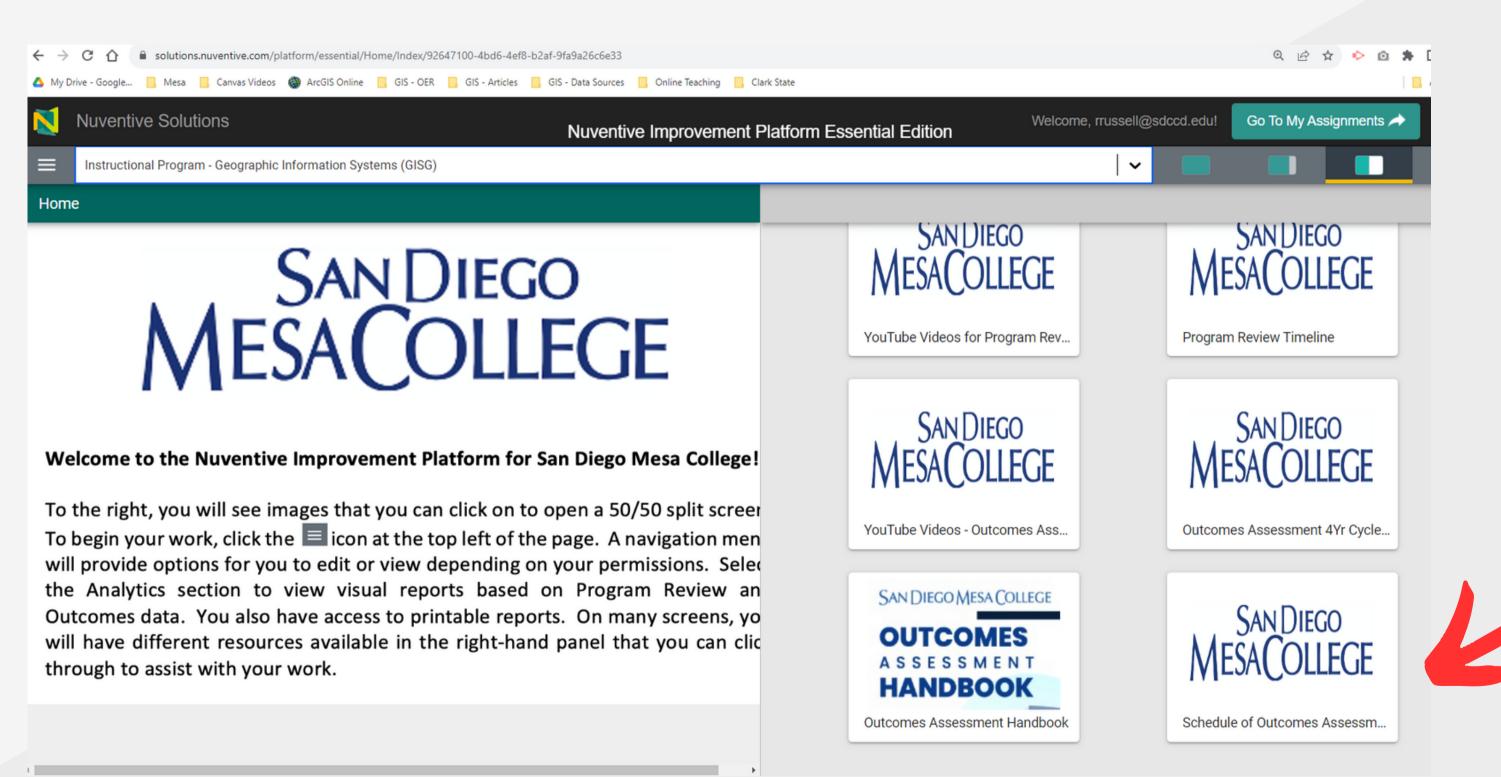
- PLOs, CLOs, SSOs must be assessed each cycle.

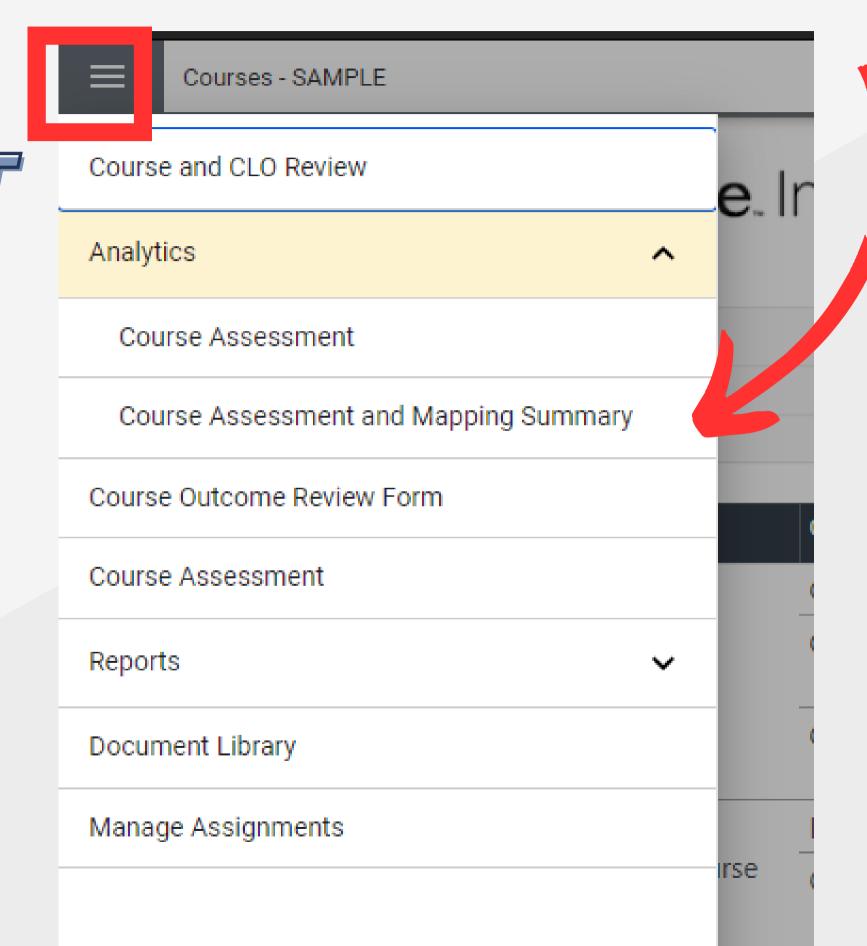

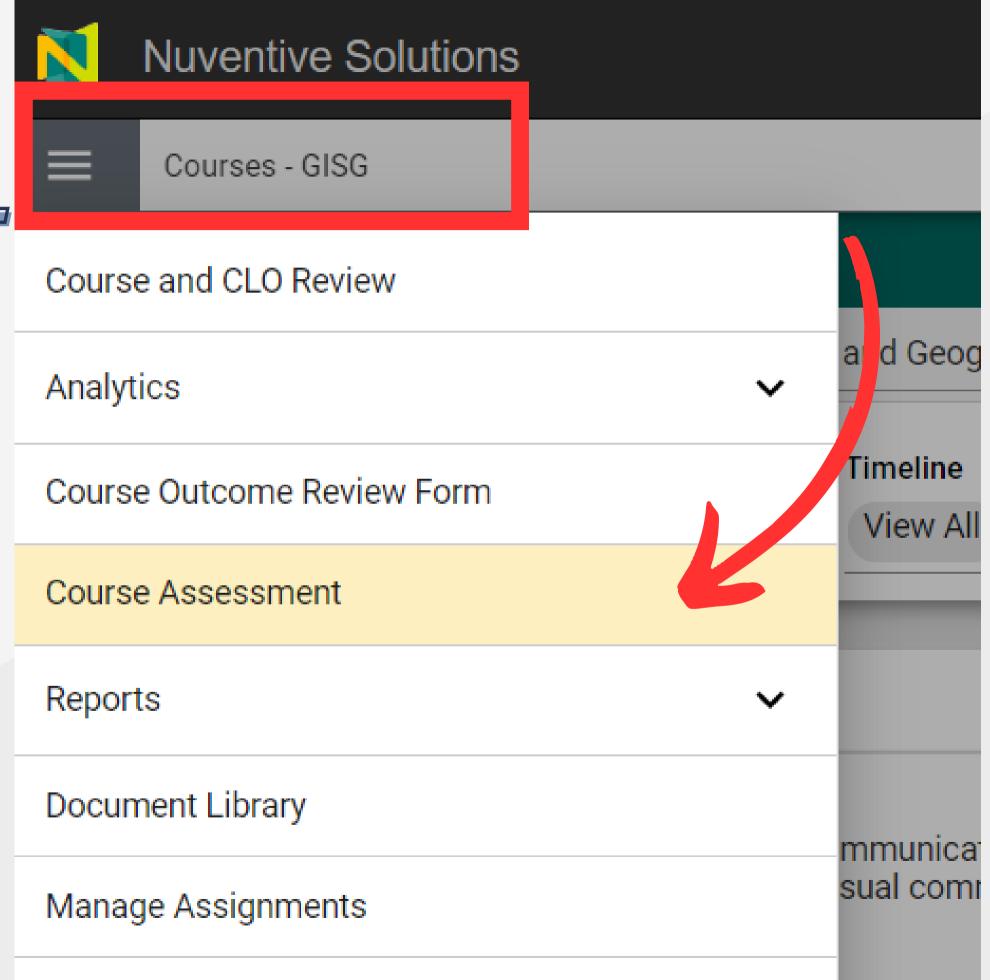
