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Standing Report--College's Progress

2019-2020 COA Goals

1. Promote a practice of meaningful dialogue around outcomes development and assessment college-wide.
2. Provide a forum to generate OA ideas and practices while sharing progress and accomplishments.
3. Incorporate outcomes assessment in Guided Pathways and the Integrated Planning Process.
4. Support faculty and staff to complete the assessment of all outcomes by the end of the current cycle.

ILO Assessment--Global Consciousness

Methodology

- Open ended question format
- Online survey
- Invitation sent to all students enrolled in identified CRNs of Task force members (n= 359)
- Incomplete responses and those who we were unable to match were removed
- 83 Total Responses
- Final results included responses from 50 students
- Responses were scored using a rubric

Results

The assessment itself was flawed. Create the rubric and the questions at the same time. Make the questions clearer and designed so students don't have to unpack the questions. Broadening the survey for greater response. How to improve the quality and thoughtfulness of the answer. Better framing of the question. Focus group. Results were a little lower than expected. But, some of the answers were pretty profound. Overall, it was a success. Great preliminary research project.

We completed CLO and AUO DOC reports in Fall 18 and began PLO reports last Spring. We will continue the reports as a method of gathering material for a repository of "Best Practices."
