OA Guide

- Guiding Principles of Outcomes Assessment
- 1. Outcomes Assessment is intended to improve student learning by systematically evaluating student performance on specific outcomes.
- The Mesa College Outcomes Assessment process is based in college-wide institutional learning outcomes.
 In instruction, Outcomes Assessment at Mesa College is faculty-driven and course-embedded. In student service areas and administrative units, Outcomes Assessment is the responsibility of those providing the services associated with the service area or unit.
- 4. Outcomes Assessment is an on-going, not episodic, process.
- 5. Outcomes assessment is about evaluating the effectiveness of programs, courses, and services, not individuals.

- Assigned from each department or program
 Fostering discussion of outcomes and assessment within your department or program
 Coordinating assessment practices
- Facilitating discussion of the results
 Identifying the next steps


