2) PRESIDENT'S REPORT

- a) District and Campus Updates: Dr. Ashanti Hands shared the following information:
- 1) Fall 2023 enrollment is up 13%.
- 2) A 250,000 grant was approved to assist adults 18-26 with their student education fees.
- 3) Generation Hope is supporting student parents (which represent 22% of the Mesa College students) by providing information at student parent cafes and creating spaces for student parents and their children. Generation Hope, a nonprofit dedicated to ensuring all student parents have the opportunities to succeed and experience economic mobility, announced that San Diego Mesa College is among one of fourteen colleges chosen in its inaugural FamilyU Seal recipients.
- 4) San Diego Mesa College Athletics has been awarded the DeVore Trophy for the 2022-23 calendar year. The DeVore Award is presented each year to a Pacific Coast Athletics Conference (PCAC) member college with the most successful men's and women's intercollegiate athletic programs for the academic year.
- 5) On Friday, September 29, 20-23, the SDCCD Black Professionals Day event was hosted by Mesa College. 6) VPI Isabel O'Connor coordinated the Dual Enrollment Workshop for SDCCD attendees on Monday, October 2, 2023.
- 7) The SDCCD Bond will be on next November ballot; our District Office will hold a study session in November 2023 to begin bond planning and will follow with educating the colleges.
- 8) Wednesday, October 18, 2023, is Promise Giving Day and the Mesa College Pep Rally.

No individual faculty will be evaluated. Faculty whose courses were randomly selected were notified of this information.
