Agenda with Meeting Notes May 6, 2014

1) PRESIDENT'S UPDATE:

- a) Welcome: President Pam Luster recognized Diane Malone, Jay Walker, and Sarah Farmer. Also, the winners of the John and Suanne Roueche Excellence Award at the League for Innovation conference this spring: Ed Helscher, Toni Parsons and Madeleine Hinkes
- b) Consent Agenda Approval: Sent via email for review on May 2, 2014: Choral Concert, May 10, 2014, 5:30 – 8:30 p.m., LRC Lobby. *Motion: Andy MacNeill;* Second: Angela Liewen. After discussion, the motion was approved unanimously.

- d) SDICCCA Update: President Pam Luster shared that discussion at the May 5, 2014 SDICCCA meeting included the impact of students with an ADT degree who will transfer to San Diego State University. It is important that SD Mesa College students are advised on having an ADT curriculum so that they can be eligible for transfer. Pam also stated that the SB 850 bill to authorize a pilot project for community college bachelor's degrees was discussed. Fifteen pilot projects statewide are being proposed.

In addition, in June the "L" trailers will be removed and the construction fence will reach the tennis courts at which time we will lose 40-50 parking spots in the H lot. The Modular Village parking spots will not be available until next spring 2015.
