1) GENERAL ITEMS (Pamela Luster, President)

Motion to approve the events listed in the above consent agenda: Motion: Madeleine Hinkes; Second: Roberto Rosas. The motion was approved unanimously.

2) COLLEGE-WIDE PLANNING (Tim McGrath, VPI)

- a) BARC Second Reading: Tim stated he had received updates from constituent groups; Academic Senate has suggested a word change and that more faculty than administrators be assigned to his committee. Pam stated that the consent for the BARC committee is already approved; recommendations can be made to amend the current proposal. The word change suggested by Academic Senate is changing "ensure" to "coordinate." Pam stated that all constituent groups need to send their suggestions/input in advance of the December 4, 2012 PCab meeting.
- b) Hiring Prioritization Process Tim will follow the standard prioritization process since BARC will not be in place until the Spring 2013 semester. Any emergency hire issues will be brought to PCab to give updates.

3) INSTRUCTION / FACILITIES (Tim McGrath, VPI)

a) Printers (Luster): Pam shared that we don't have a District standard for printers – it is a local decision that has cost-related issues. SD Mesa College needs to look at how we budget items with impacted cost-related issues, such as purchasing personal printers, printer support, funds for ink cartridges and what will happen when the discretionary funds are reduced. Pam recommended that the facilities committee review this issue and gather information on purchase, support, upkeep and the types of printing jobs being done on personal vs network vs reprographic printers as well as FF&E allowance for new buildings that will cover purchase of printers.

4) STUDENT SERVICES (Ashanti Hands for Denise Whisenhunt)

a) Principal's Roundtable: Ashanti reported that 11 principals were invited to attend – 8 have confirmed, for the 11-7-12 meeting at SD Mesa College.
