## Mesa College is "Making History"!

In 2018, Mesa College will again make history by awarding over 1,700 Associate degrees and over 800 ADTs. Most monumental is that we will also award our first Bachelor of Science degrees in Health Information Management (HIM) to fifteen students. The HIM program provides accessible, high-quality, industry-approved instruction designed to prepare students to work at a management level. We will also be graduating our first Promise students. Started in 2016, the Promise Program provides free tuition for one year at a California community college to full time students. This year, Antonio Martinez is receiving Mesa's Distinguished Alumni Award. Mr. Martinez graduated from Mesa in 2005, and transferred to the University of Pennsylvania, where he earned a degree in Philosophy, Politics, and Economics. Currently, Mr. Martinez serves as the Director of Public Relations at Imperial Beach Community Clinic.

On Friday, April 20, we had the opportunity to celebrate our 25<sup>th</sup> Scholarship Awards Ceremony, and it was a huge success. We reached two new record goals; awarding over \$240,000 in scholarships to 175 students, with 65 students receiving more than one scholarship. The Opportunity Drawing and Silent auction raised over \$3,000 for the San Diego Promise.
