Faculty will understand the complexity and diversity within the Asian American and Pacific Islander communities.


Faculty will develop a sense of community with other participants through discussions and activities.

Faculty will understand the challenges that AAPI students experience and strategies to supporting them.

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
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
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Impact of AAPI CoP - (Pre Survey)







Impact of AAPI CoP - (Post Survey)

Q4 After receiving the training, please assess about how you agree with the statements below.








Impact of AAPI CoP - (Side by Side)

Q7 Please identify about how you agree with the statements below.




