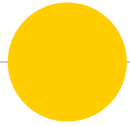

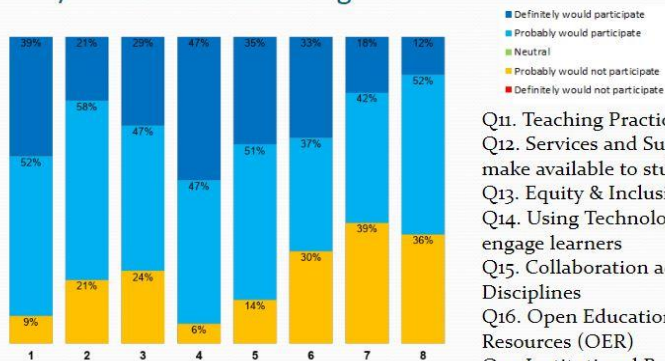

How likely would you be to participate in Flex/Professional Learning activities offered?

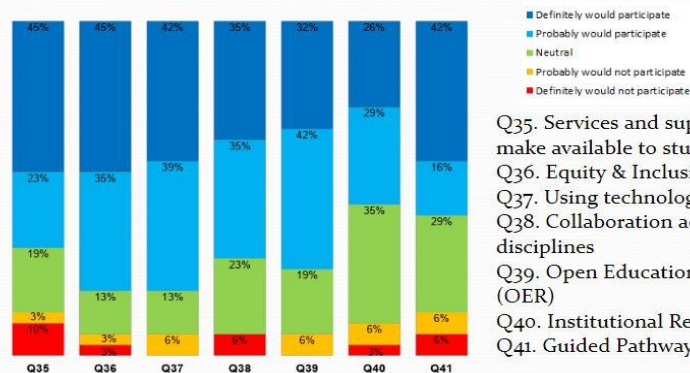

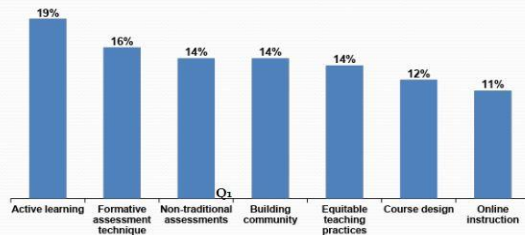

Teaching Topics of Interest

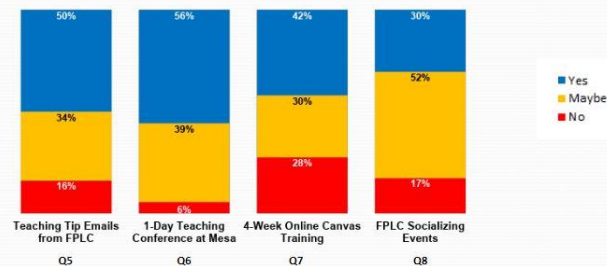

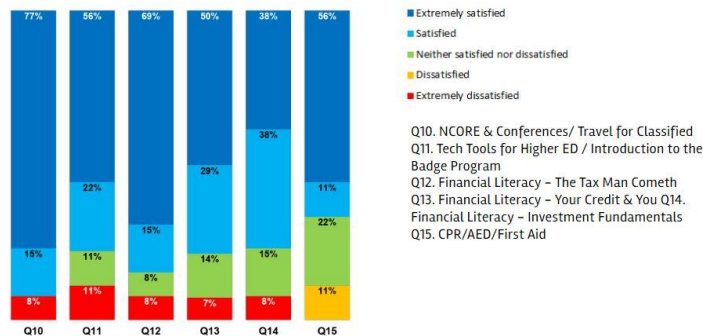

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Course Redesign Institute

Preliminary Data (Pre/Post- 2018)

- **Retention** – Overall, the retention rate of redesigned courses increased by four percentage points.
- **Success** – Overall, the success rate of redesigned courses increased by six percentage points.
- **Course GPA** – Overall, the course GPA remained unchanged.

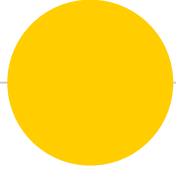
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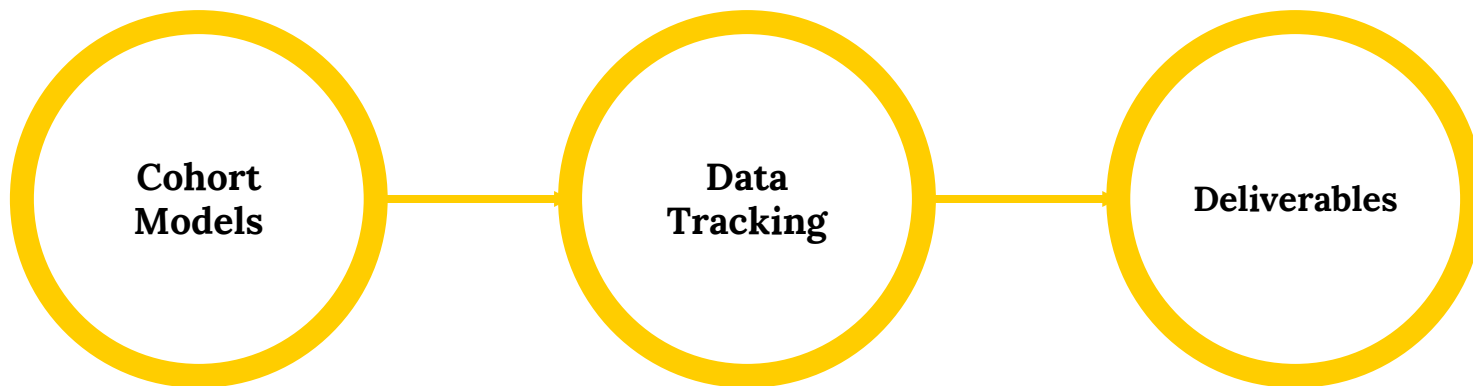


Fall Convocation - 2019
