

How likely would you be to participate in Flex/Professional Learning activities offered?





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How likely would you be to participate in Flex/Professional Learning activities offered on the following topics?







<u>Course Redesign Institute</u> <u>Preliminary Data (Pre/Post- 2018)</u>

- **Retention** -Overall, the retention rate of redesigned courses increased by four percentage points.
- **Success** Overall, the success rate of redesigned courses increased by six percentage points.
- **Course GPA**-Overall, the course GPA remained unchanged.
