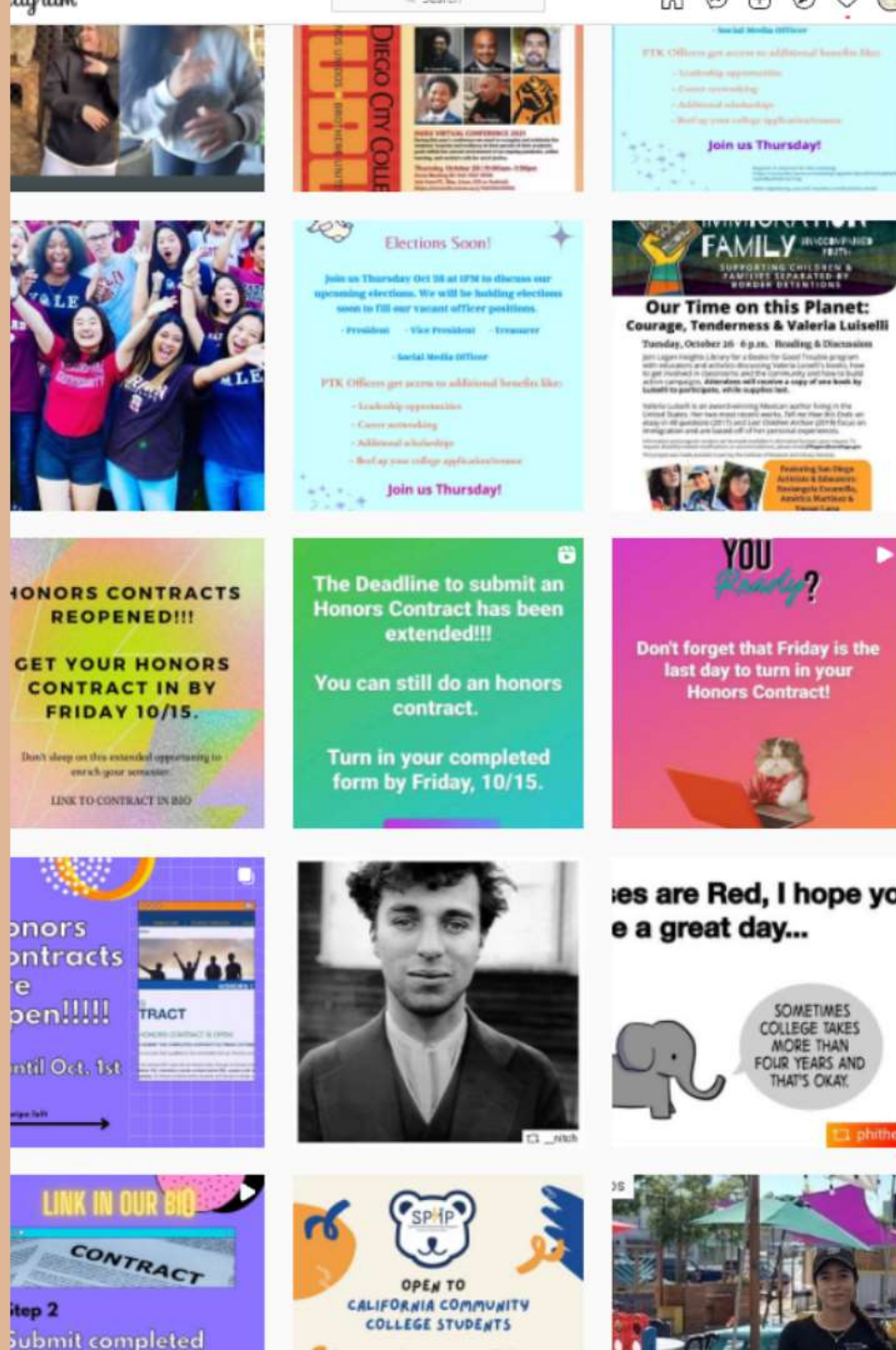


Her personal life, I was like "It need to be told"
