Rationale for Change

- Outdated data retrieving tool
- Growing data needs



How: Temporary Pause on Ad Hoc and New Requests

To facilitate this transition, we have decided to temporarily pause ad hoc requests until June 30.



Reasons for the Pause

- Time Required for Skill Acquisition: Learning new tools and languages takes time and dedication.
- Reduction in Staff: With Block grant ending soon, it is likely we will loose NANCE support.
- **Full plate:** We have enough projects in our queue to keep us busy through the beginning of the Fall.

Benefits of the Transition

- Data automation → faster access to new data
- New partnerships with research team to unlock actionable insights



Next Steps

- Ad hoc projects on hold: We will pause ad hoc projects during this transition period.
- We are not clearing our plate: We will continue to fulfill our existing commitments, which include 30 ongoing projects already in our Spring Research agenda.
- Continued support of mandated reports.
- IE Request form remains open: The service request will remain open to capture new request. They will be added to queue but will not be reviewed until July.
