# PCAB Report - Mesa Pathways 9.20.22

#### **Mesa Pathways Funding Update:**

Mesa College will be receiving its first installment of one-time Guided Pathways funding from the Chancellor's office to ensure that Mesa continues its integration of Mesa Pathways into our structures and practices equity.

Priority areas for the Guided Pathways funds are:

- SEA Program
- Associate Degrees for Transfer (ADTs)
- Zero Textbook Cost (ZTC) Programs
- Adult Education
- Strong Workforce

Mesa is required to submit an Acknowledgement of Assurance by September 30, 2022 to certify that the college agrees to comply with the program requirements. The Mesa Pathways Committee (MPC) will also be working on a Guided Pathways 2022-26 Workplan to be submitted by March 2023. We are awaiting the content and structure from the Chancellor's Office.

#### **Student Success Teams (SSTs):**

Our Student Success Team continues to strategically and intentionally communicate with the pilot SST group with targeted email communications on a biweekly basis. Additionally, a plan for upcoming contacts with students has been created and continues to be updated. The theme of the third contact with students focused on focusing a sense of belonging, encouraging participation in Club Rush and SST virtual office hours. Students were also introduced to <a href="Career Compass">Career Compass</a>, the Pathways Fellows who are on the Student Success Teams, and the <a href="Job Board">Job Board</a>. Additional ideas and themes are being discussed for future emails to students, including financial aid resources and registration reminders.

## **Data Coaches Project Team:**

The Data Coaching training program is underway with nine participants, including faculty and classified professionals from across campus. Meetings are scheduled through late-November, and will consist of in-person meetings and asynchronous materials offered through Canvas to help guide participants to work on mini-data projects that will be presented at the end of the training course. The goal is to prepare data coaches to assist with projects across campus starting in Fall 2023. Additionally, a meeting is scheduled with Dr. Al Solano to learn what other campuses have done/are doing with regard to data coaches.
