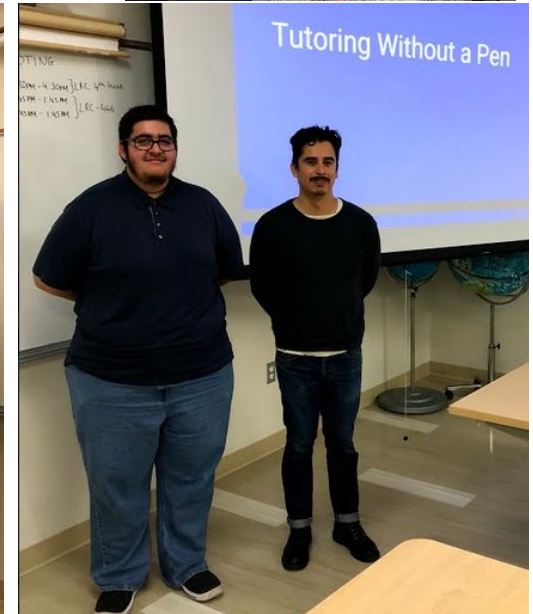

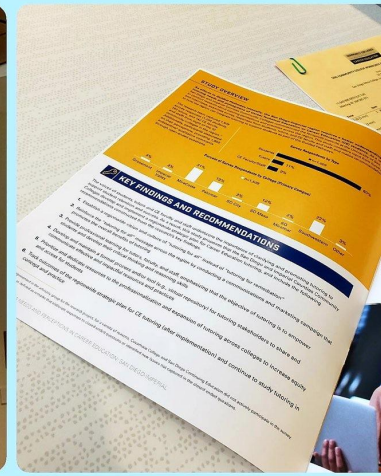
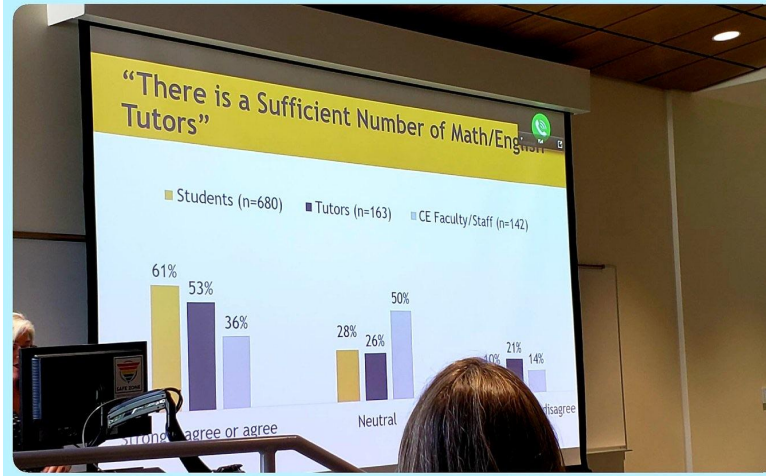
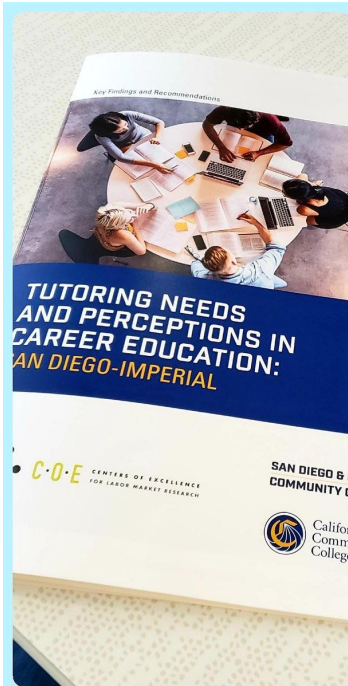


Tutors, Faculty, and Staff Conference Attendance



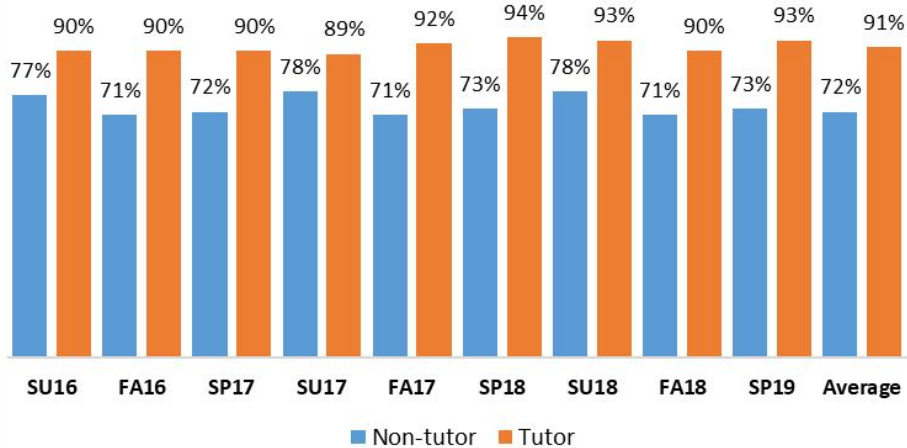

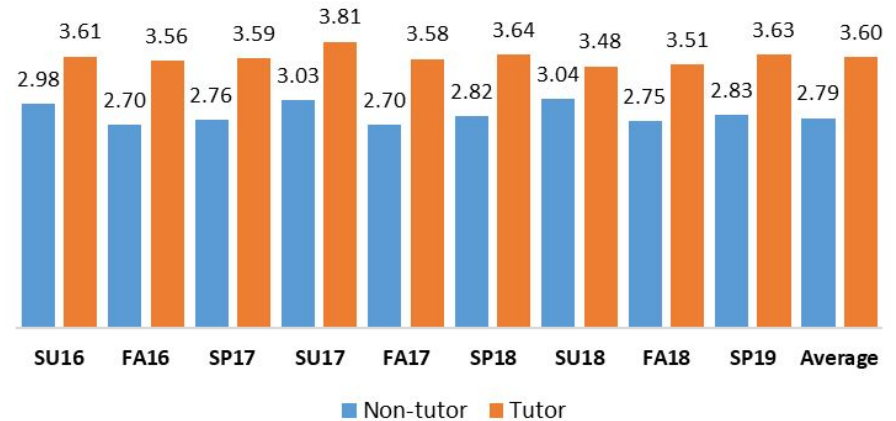


MT2C TUTOR COURSE OUTCOMES AT MESA

Mesa Course Success Rate

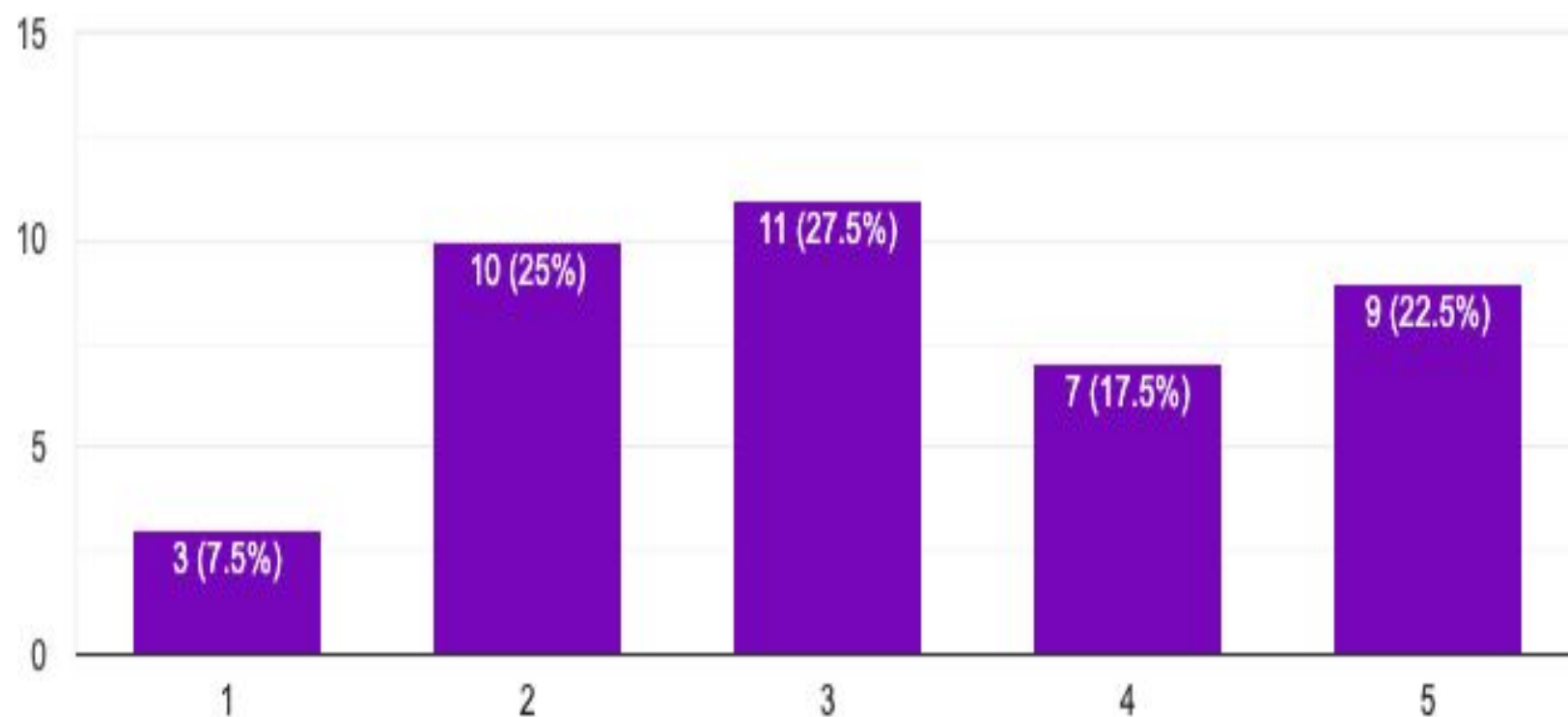


Average Term GPA on Mesa Courses



Before joining MT2C, how interested were you in becoming a teacher/working in the educational field?

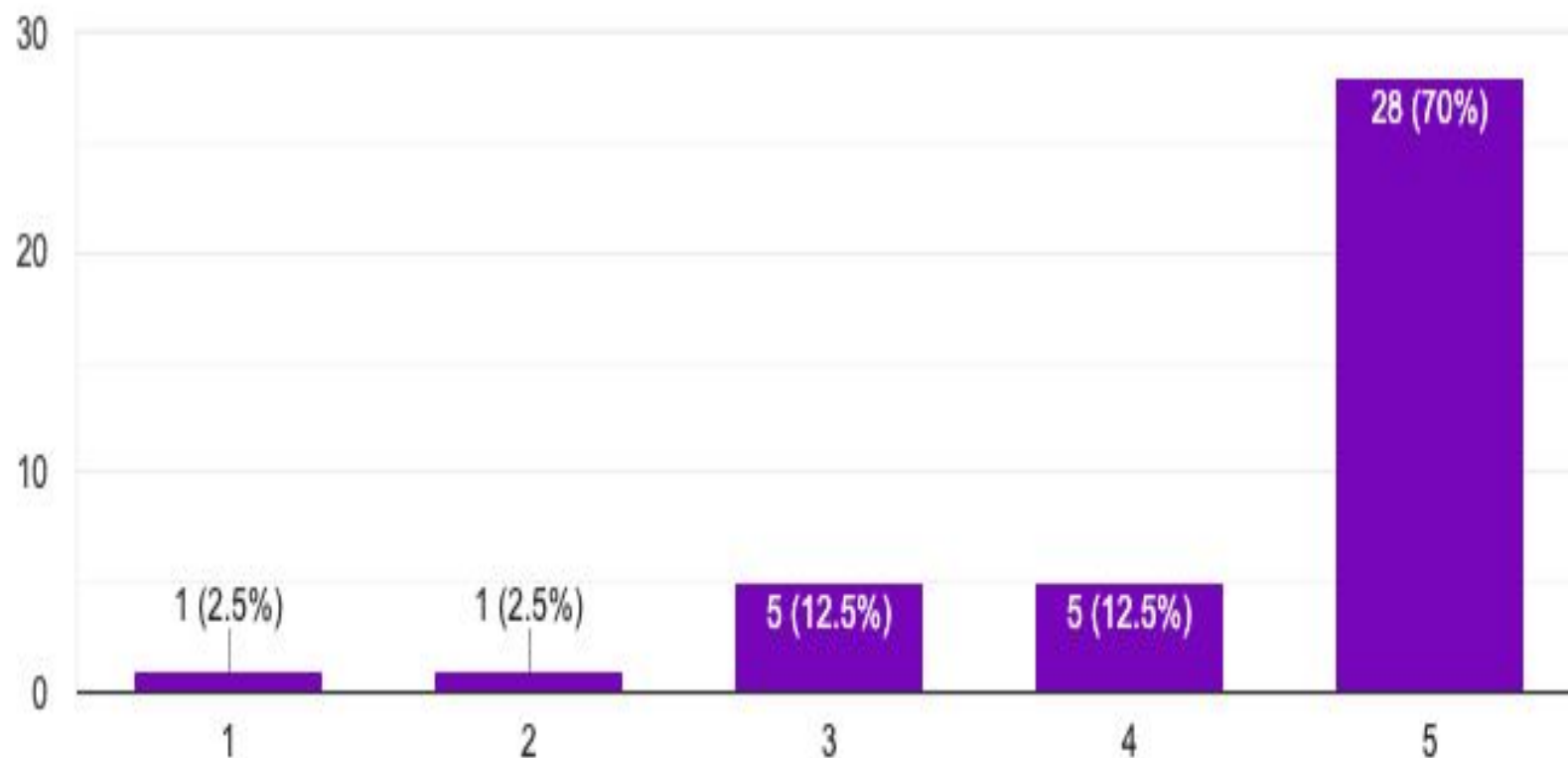

How interested are you now in becoming a teacher/working in the educational field?

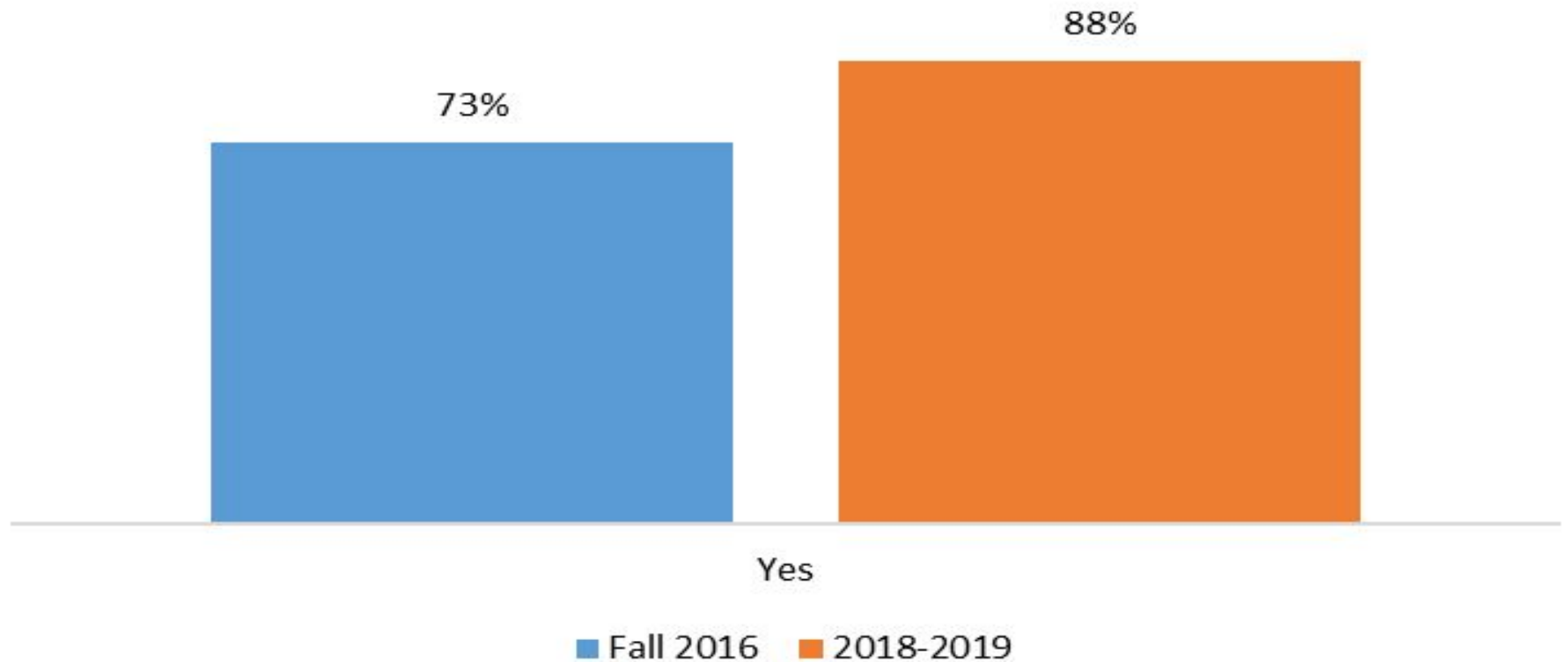

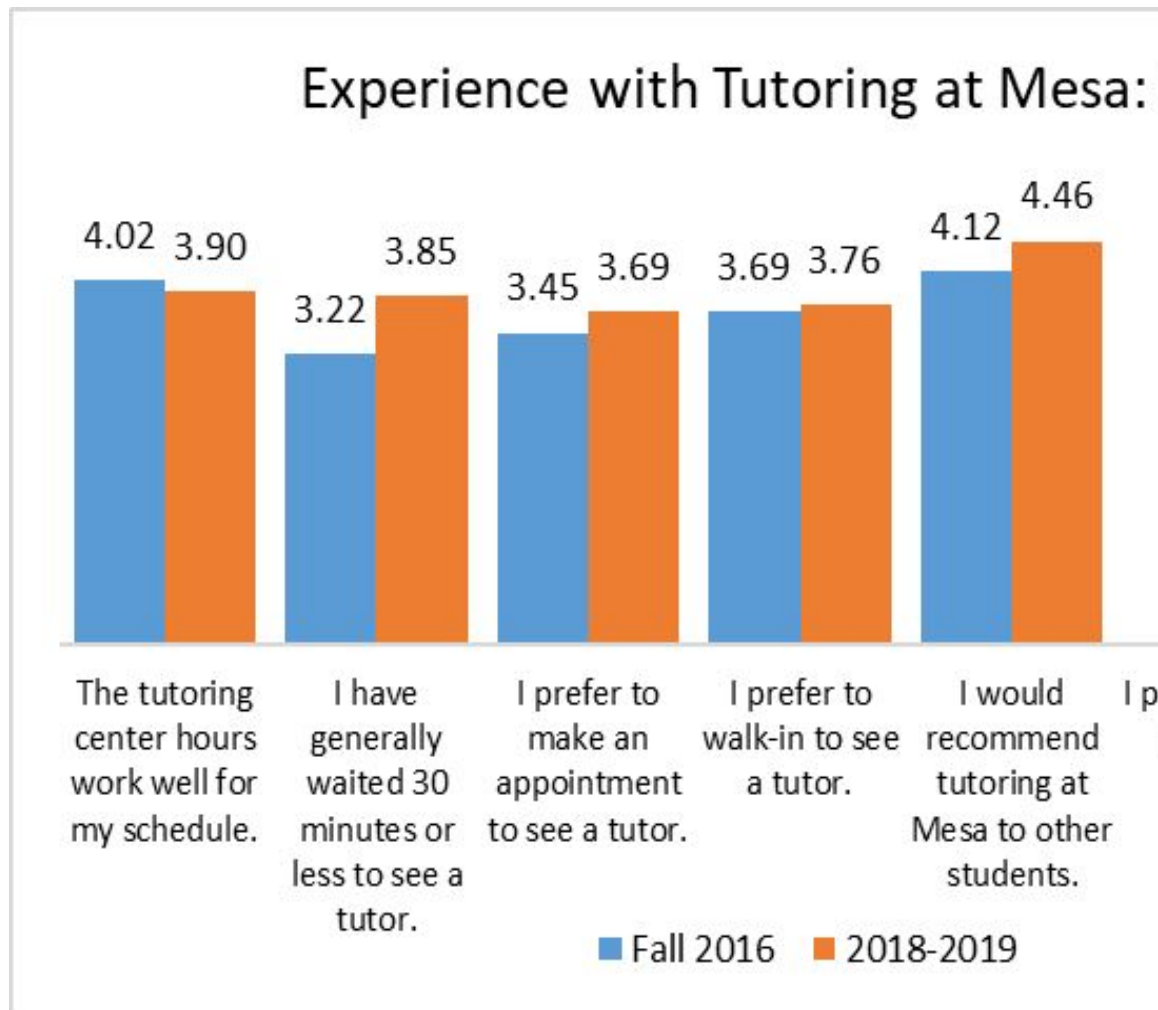


MESA COLLEGE TUTORING PERCEPTION SURVEY (2018-19)

Familiarity of MT2C



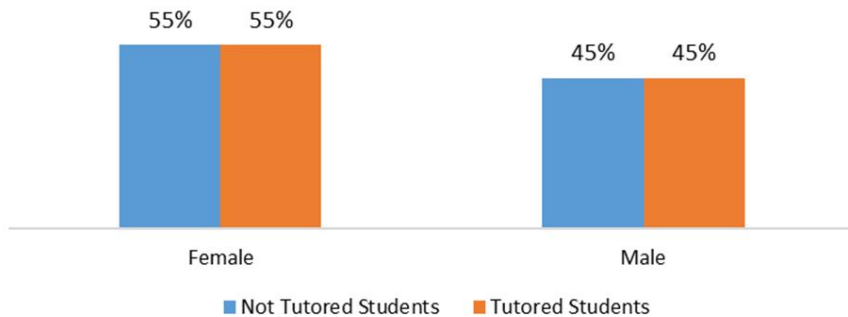
MESA COLLEGE TUTORING PERCEPTION SURVEY (2018-19)



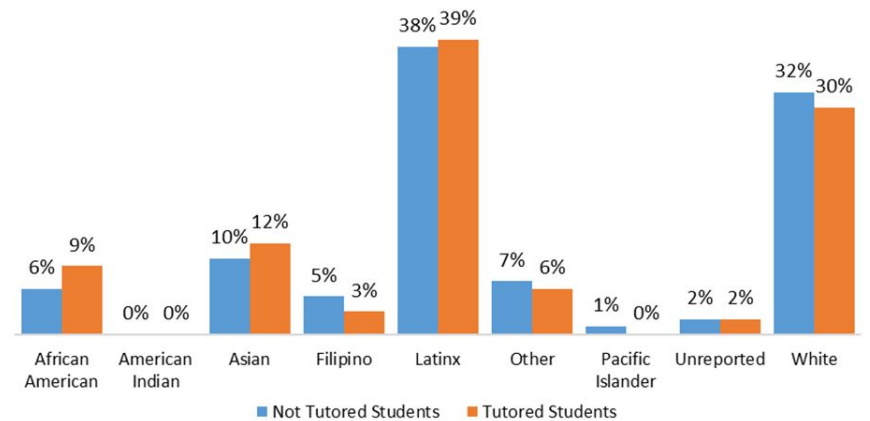
94% of respondents agreed/strongly agreed that they would recommend tutoring at Mesa to other students

STUDENT DEMOGRAPHIC PROFILE

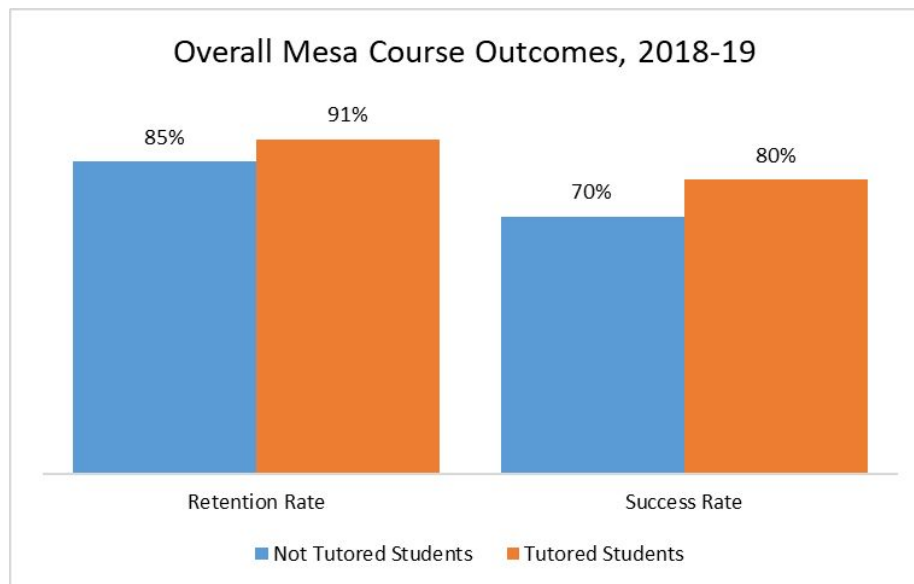
Gender

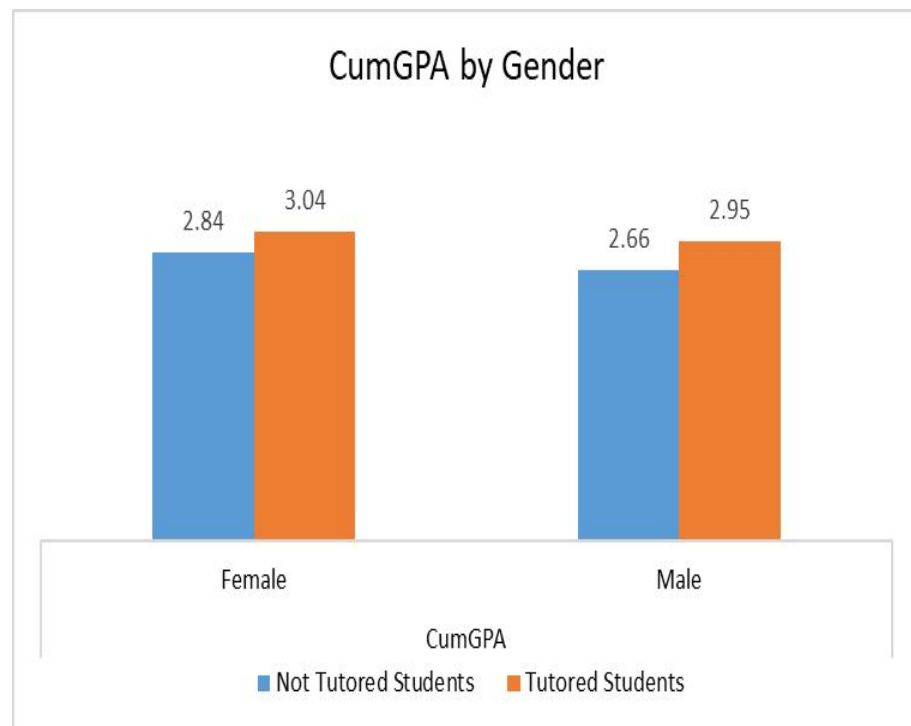
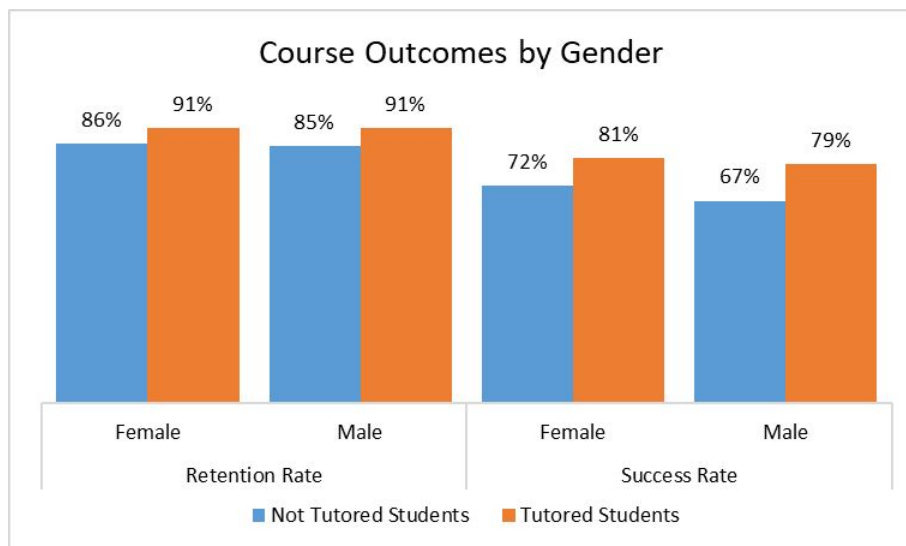


COMPREHENSIVE TUTORING DATA ANALYSIS

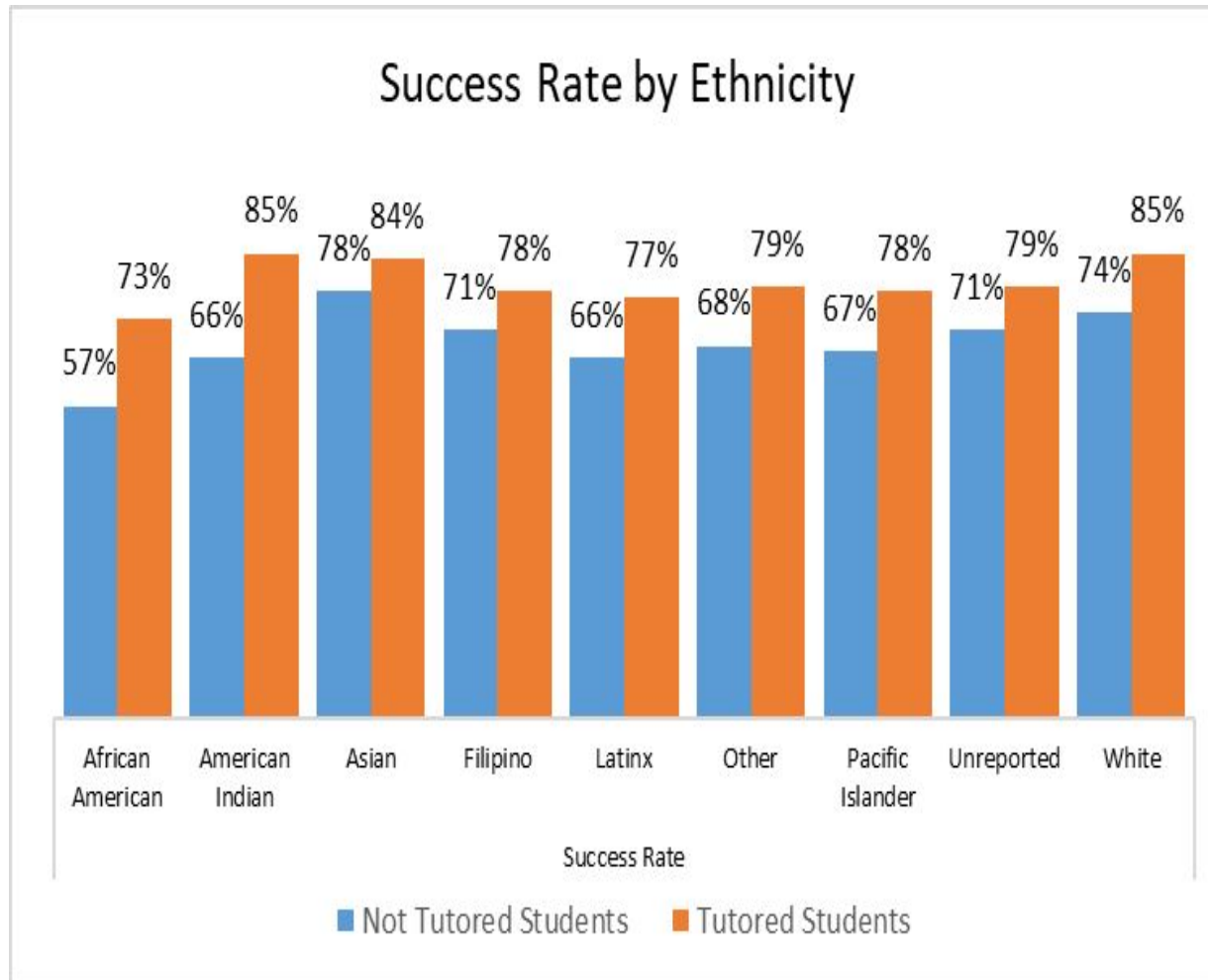


- Tutored students consistently have higher course retention and success rate compared to students who have not used tutoring services.

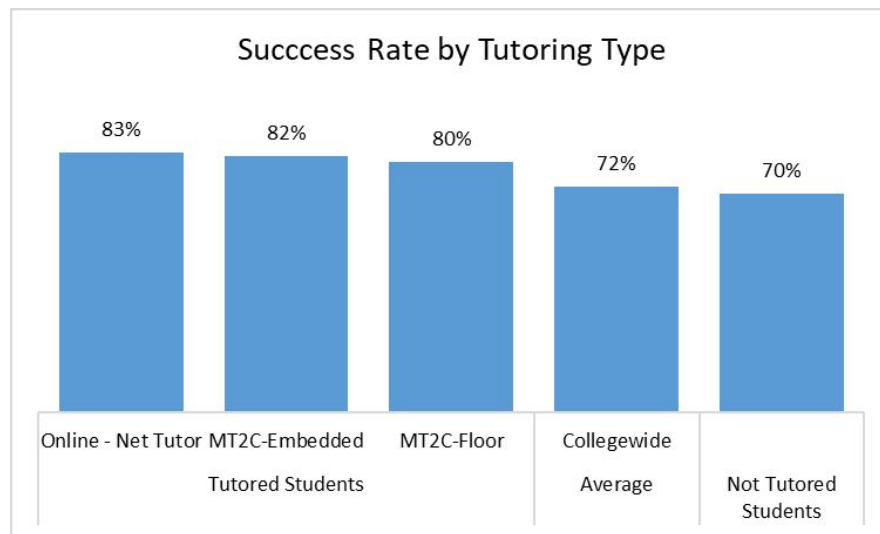
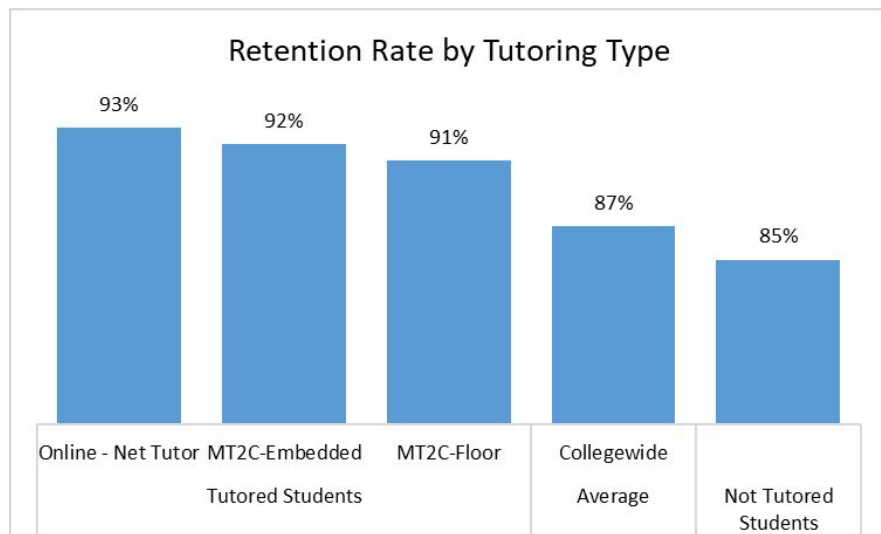
