Summary of Results from Path to STEM Success

- STEM Interest:
 - Attending the orientation appears to have increased students' interest in pursuing a STEM career.
 - Increase interest in pursuing a STEM career from 68% extremely interested to 85%
- STEM Identity:
 - Increased sense of belonging score among Latinx students from 3.7 to 4.1 on a 5 point scale


