Puente Works! Statewide Data


- 84% of Puente students enroll in three continuous terms compared with 72% of all CCC students.
- Over half (52%) of Puente community college students transfer to four-year institutions, compared with transfer rates for all CCC students statewide and CCC underrepresented students at 41% and 33% respectively.




